

DESIGN FOR FURNITURE-DRAWERS.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,717, dated June 11, 1878; application filed May 24, 1878. [Term of patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDWIN HART, of Cleveland, in the county of Cuyahoga and State of Ohio, have originated and designed a Pattern for Furniture Drawers; and I do hereby declare the following to be a full, clear, and exact description of the same, such as will enable others skilled in the art to which it pertains to make and use it, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, which forms part of this specification.

My design is intended for the face of furniture drawers, especially for sewing-machines.

A represents the main surface or face of the drawer, in the center of which is made the spherical depression B, at the bottom and central portion of which is attached a knob or handle, C, which should come but little, if any, beyond the face or plate A.

D D are four raised panels, arranged sub-

stantially as shown in the drawing, in such a manner as that the spaces between these four panels shall present the appearance of a cross.

The parts described may be composed of either the same or of different descriptions of wood to suit the fancy or produce an attractive or harmonious effect.

What I claim as my invention is—

A design for a drawer-face having the face A, depression B, knob C, and panels D, fashioned and arranged substantially in the manner herein set forth.
