

DESIGN FOR FRINGE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,720, dated June 11, 1878; application filed June 3, 1878. [Term of patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EDMUND GREASLY, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have produced or invented a new and original Design for a Fringe, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a fringe consists essentially of pendent cords a alternating with pendent cords b, considerably less in size than the cords a. The character of the cords a and b is too fully shown in the drawing to need detailed description.

In Figure 1 1 have shown the cords a and b alternating regularly, and in Fig. 2 I have shown two cords, b, between adjacent cords a.

It will thus be seen that the number and arrangement of the cords a and b may be modified without departing from the essential characteristics of the design.

The fringe may be combined with any style of heading which the taste of the manufacturer may suggest, the heading forming no part of my design.

I claim-

The design for a fringe, comprising pendent cords a alternating with cords b, less in size than the cords a, all substantially as shown and described.
