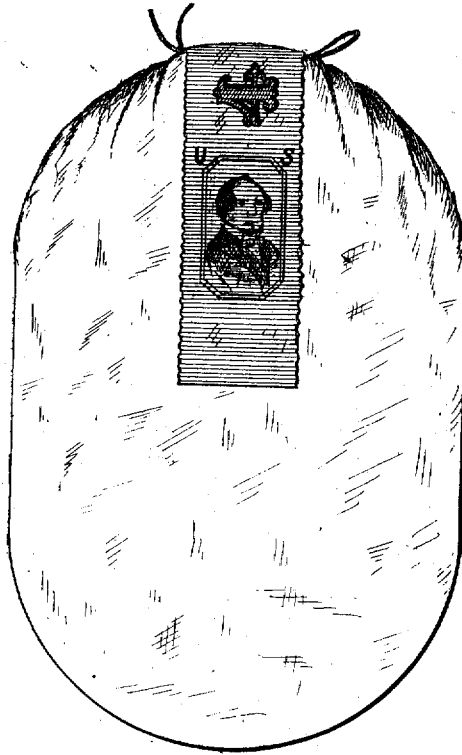
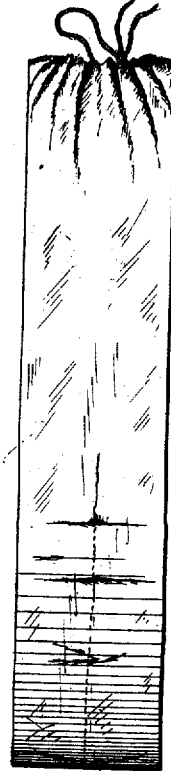

DESIGN FOR TOBACCO-BAGS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,725**, dated June 18, 1878; application filed March 19, 1878.
[Term of patent 14 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, WILLIAM J. CUSSEN, of Richmond, in the county of Henrico, and in the State of Virginia, have invented a certain new and useful Design for Tobacco-Bags; and do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, making a part of this specification.

My design consists of a tobacco-bag made in the new and original shape or configuration shown in the accompanying drawings.

Figure 1 represents a plan view, and Fig. 2 an edge view.

The bag, when filled, is in the form of an oval with its sides flattened.

This tobacco-bag is beautiful in form and

original in shape, as well as being easily carried in the pocket, without taking up much room.

What I claim is—

The design for tobacco-bags shown, formed with rounded tops and bottoms, and flat sides and edges.
