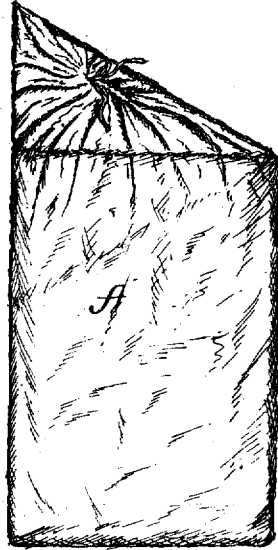

## DESIGN FOR TOBACCO-BAGS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,726**, dated June 18, 1878; application filed February 11, 1878.  
[Term of patent 14 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, WILLIAM J. CUSSEN, of Richmond, in the county of Henrico, and in the State of Virginia, have invented a certain new and useful Design for Tobacco-Bags; and do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, making a part of this specification.

My design consists in making a tobacco bag or package in triangular form, as shown.

A represents my design, which is a bag made in triangular form in cross-section.

The bag can be of any size.

What I claim is—

The within design for tobacco-bags, made in triangular form, as shown in the accompanying drawings.
