

DESIGN FOR HOBBY-HORSES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,734, dated June 25, 1878; application filed May 31, 1878. [Term of patent 3\frac{1}{2} years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, OTTO UNZICKER, of Chicago, in the county of Cook and State of Illinois, have originated a new Design for a Child's Hobby-Horse, which is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification, in which—

A represents the body of a small horse, and B the rockers, bent to the shape and attached to said body, as shown in the photographic illustration.

What I claim as my invention is-

The design for a child's hobby-horse composed of the body A and rockers B, substantially as described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.
