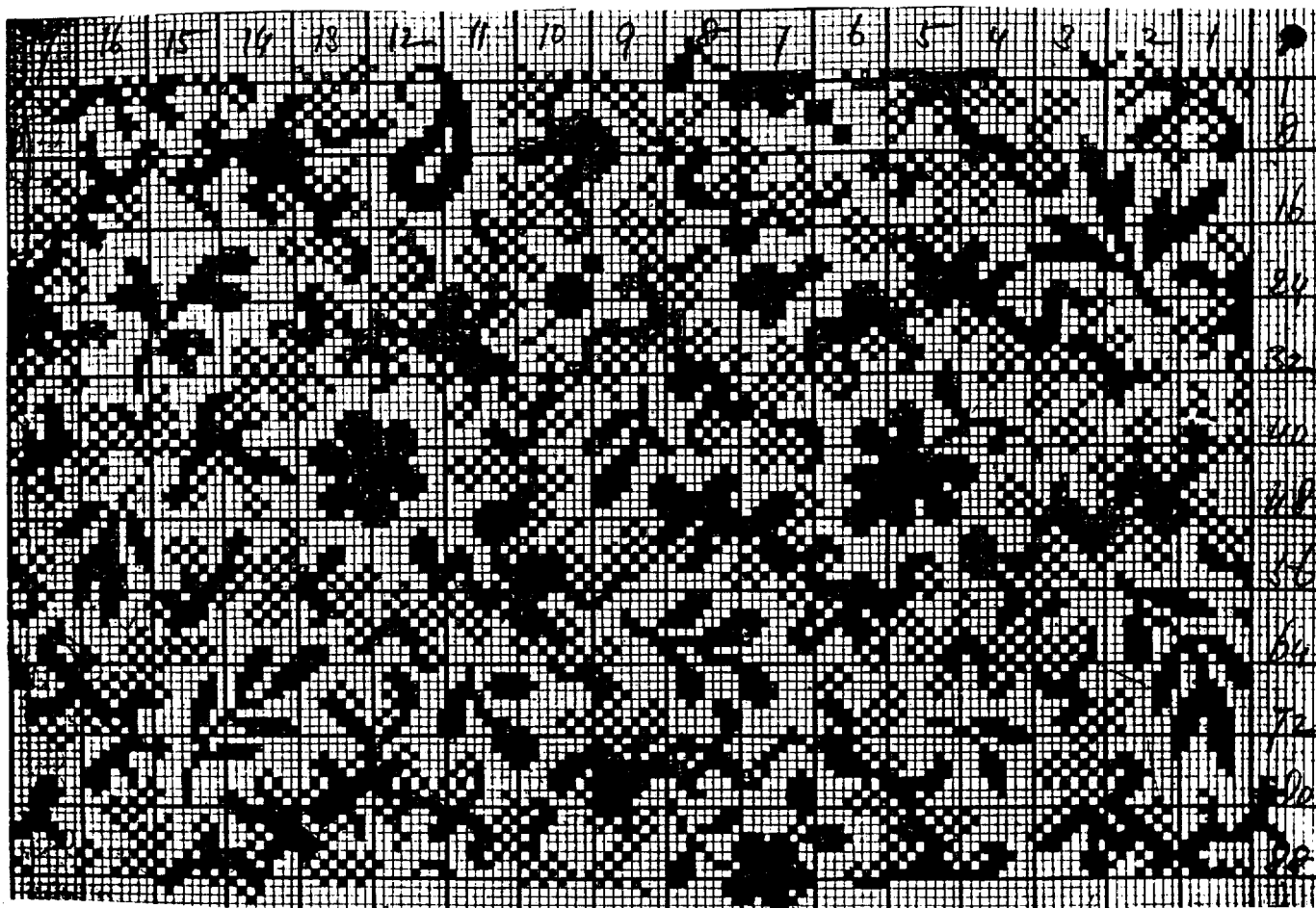

DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,735**, dated July 2, 1878; application filed June 10, 1878.
[Term of patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

My design is shown by the accompanying photographic illustration, and is of a foliated character throughout, consisting of stems, leaves, and blossoms arranged upon a plain ground, in a manner too fully shown to need accurate description.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—
The design for a carpet-pattern, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
