

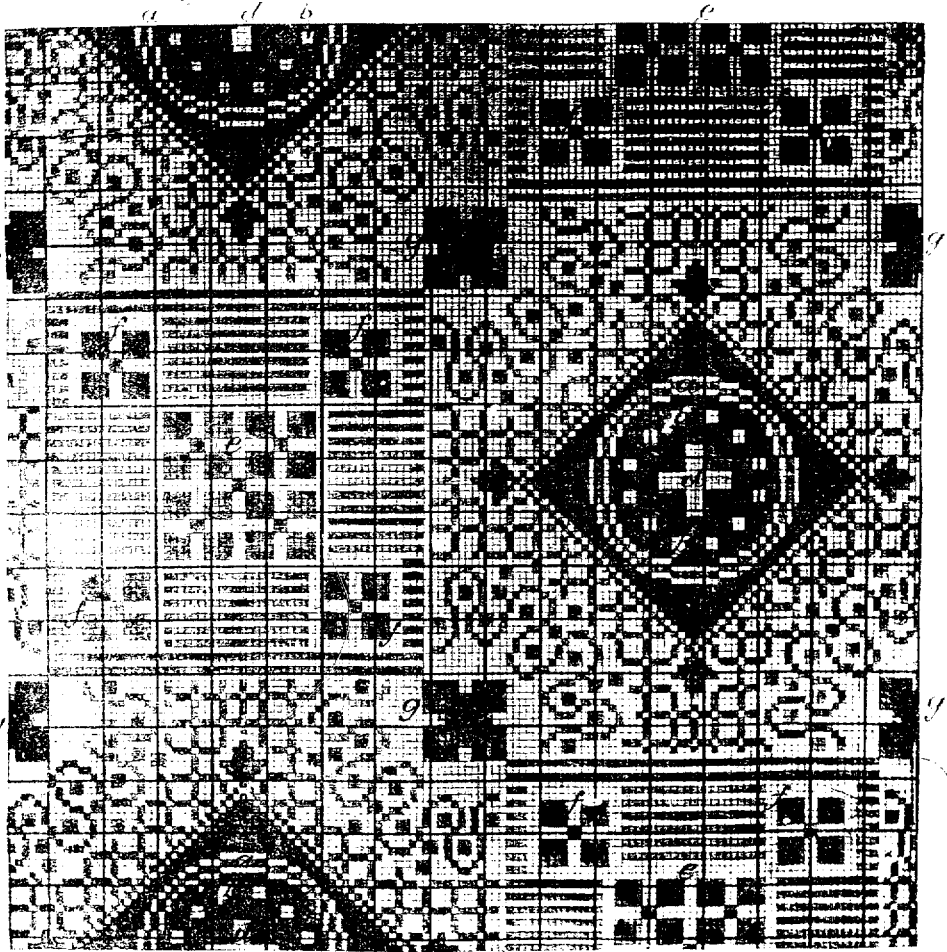

## DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,736**, dated July 2, 1878; application filed June 10, 1878.  
[Term of patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

My design is shown by the accompanying photographic illustration, and comprises two main figures, A and B, both of which are of a square form.

The figure A contains a ring, *a*, a circle of dots, *b*, and a central cruciform ornament, *d*. The body of the figure B is composed of line-work, and said figure has a central ornament, *e*, and corner ornaments *f*, both the central and corner ornaments consisting of a number of square blocks, arranged as shown.

The figures A and B are arranged upon a mottled groundwork, in which are also small ornaments *g*.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—  
The design for a carpet-pattern, substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying drawing.
