

## DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,737, dated July 2, 1878; application filed June 10, 1878. [Term of patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

My design is shown in the accompanying

photographic illustration, and is of a combined foliated and scroll-like character, comprising scrolls A, flowers B, and leaves D, the whole being arranged on a mottled groundwork in a manner which is too fully shown to need accurate description.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim-The design for a carpet-pattern, substantially as described, and as illustrated in and by the accompanying drawing.
