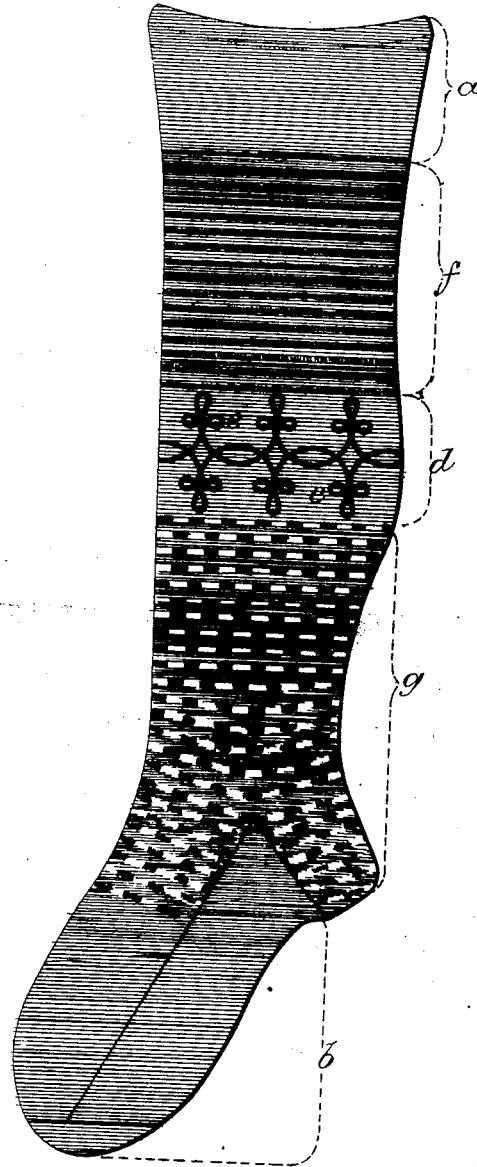

## DESIGN FOR STOCKING.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,761**, dated July 30, 1878; application filed July 1, 1878.  
[Term of patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, MARTIN LANDENBERGER, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Stocking, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a stocking is fully shown in the accompanying drawing, which represents a side view of the stocking. The top *a* of the leg and the foot *b* of the stocking are plain. About midway of the leg of the stocking is a band, *d*, ornamented by embroidery *e*, the background for which is formed by the plain body of the stocking. Between this band *d* and the plain top *a* of the leg intervenes a portion, *f*, ornamented by plain horizontal stripes, and between the band *d* and the foot *b* intervenes a portion, *g*, ornamented by mottled stripes.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

1. The design for a stocking having the embroidered stripe *d*, as shown and described.
2. The design for a stocking comprising the embroidered stripe *d* and plain striped portion *f*, as shown and described.
3. The design for a stocking comprising the embroidered stripe *d* and mottled portion *g*, as shown and described.
4. The design for a stocking comprising the embroidered stripe *d*, plain striped portion *f*, and mottled portion *g*, as shown and described.
