

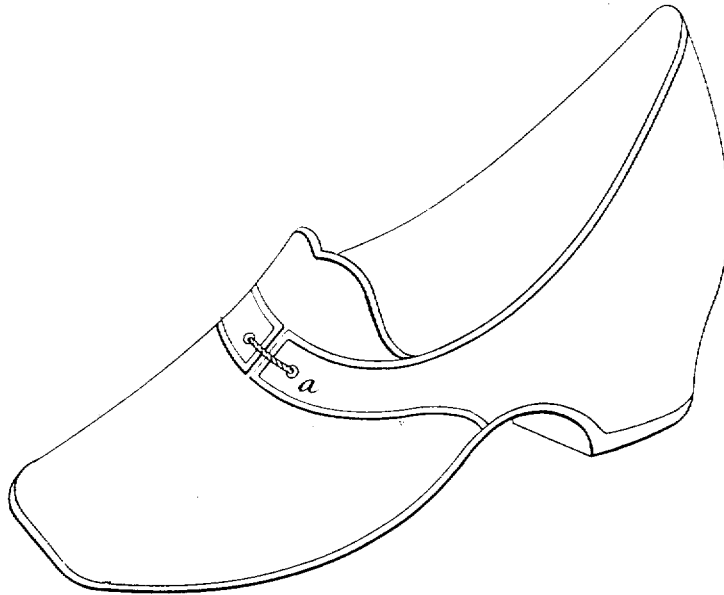

## DESIGN FOR OVERSHOES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,774**, dated August 6, 1878; application filed July 12, 1878.  
[Term of patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, GEO. WATKINSON, of New Haven, in the county of New Haven and State of Connecticut, have invented a new Improvement in Design for Overshoes; and I do hereby declare the following, when taken in connection with the accompanying drawing and the letters of reference marked thereon, to be a full, clear, and exact description of the same, and which said drawing constitutes part of this specification, and represents in the figure a perspective view.

This invention relates to a design for overshoes; and consists in the configuration, as hereinafter described, and shown in the accompanying illustration.

The general outline of the shoe is substan-

tially of usual form. The counters are represented as extending forward over the front, as at *a*, in imitation of a strap laced together, such representation being as an ornament to the shoe; and this representation of a lacing-strap is the essential characteristic of this design.

I claim—

A design for overshoes, representing an imitation of lacing-straps as extending from the counters over the front and laced together, as shown in the accompanying illustration.
