DESIGN FOR CARPET.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, CHARLES MAGEE, of Brooklyn, Kings county, and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Carpet, of which the following is a specification:

This invention relates to a new design for a carpet, oil-cloth, or similar fabric; and consists in the new arrangement and ornamentation of figures hereinafter described.

The background of the carpet is made in

two colors, the main background, A, having fields a of a different color, and without a clearly-defined outline. Upon the background of the carpet are also represented a tree, b, a cluster of leaves, c, a scroll, d, and a bouquet of flowers and leaves, c, as shown.
