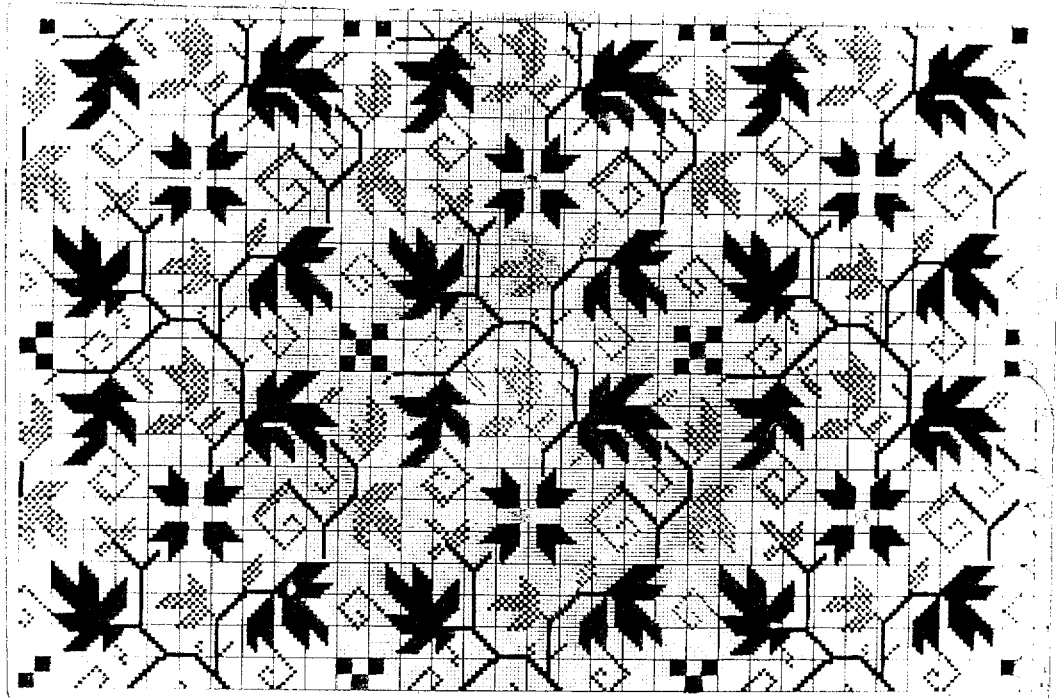

DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,798**, dated September 10, 1878; application filed August 22, 1878.
