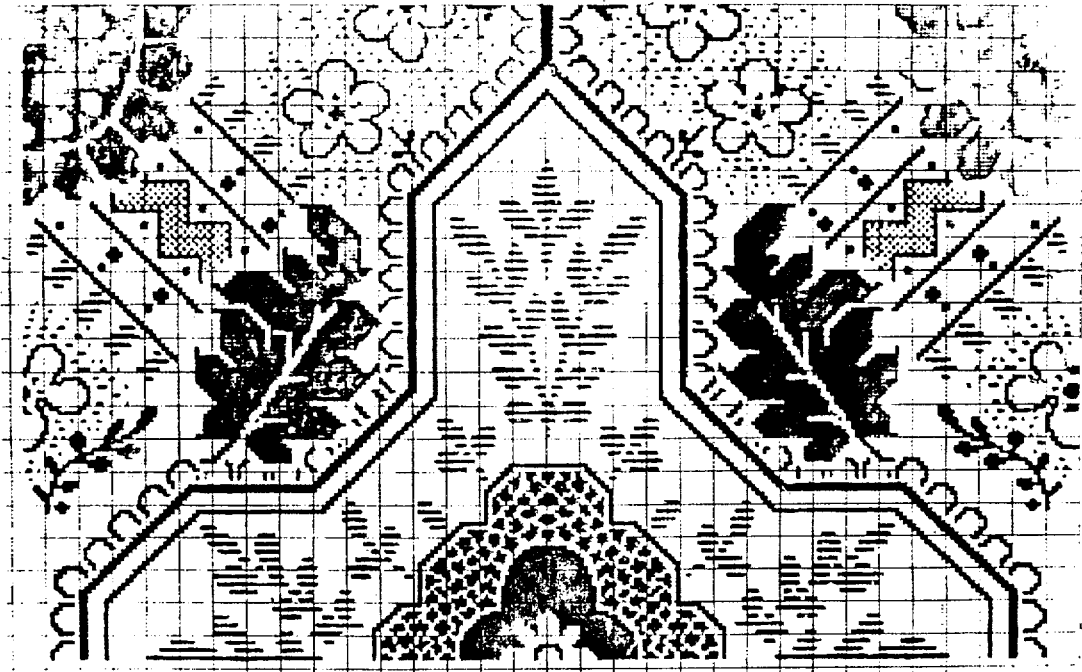

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,812**, dated September 10, 1878; application filed August 22, 1878.
[Term of patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:
