



DESIGN FOR CIGAR-BOX.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,828, dated September 10, 1878; application filed August 17, 1878. [Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GUSTAV JACOBY, of New York city, county and State of New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Cigar-Box, of which the following is a specification:

This invention relates to a new and original design for a cigar-box; and consists in the new configuration of the box hereinafter described.

In the accompanying drawings, Figure 1 is a perspective view of my newly-designed cigar-box. Fig. 2 is a top view of the same.
Similar letters of reference indicate corre-

sponding parts in both figures.

The letter A represents the newly-designed eigar-box. The same is made of sheet metal

or equivalent material, and has four sides, a a, the bottom b, and cover c, in the customary manner. The four sides, as well as the top and bottom of the box, are bulged outward, as shown, thus forming a box of peculiar and striking appearance. The corners are moreover slightly raised from the surface of the box, as shown in Fig. 1.

I claim—
The design for a cigar-box, substantially as shown.
