

DESIGN FOR CARPETING.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,846**, dated October 1, 1878; application filed July 12, 1878. [Term of patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ROBERT ALLAN, of the city of Yonkers, county of Westchester, and State of New York, have invented or produced a new and original Design for a Pattern to be Inwrought into Tapestry Brussels and other Carpeting, similar to the photographs accompanying this specification; and I do hereby declare that the photographs accompanying this specification do give and convey to any one skilled in the art of carpet-weaving a defined and thorough description of the nature of my in-

vention, that is sufficient to enable any one skilled in the art of carpet-weaving to use my invention.
