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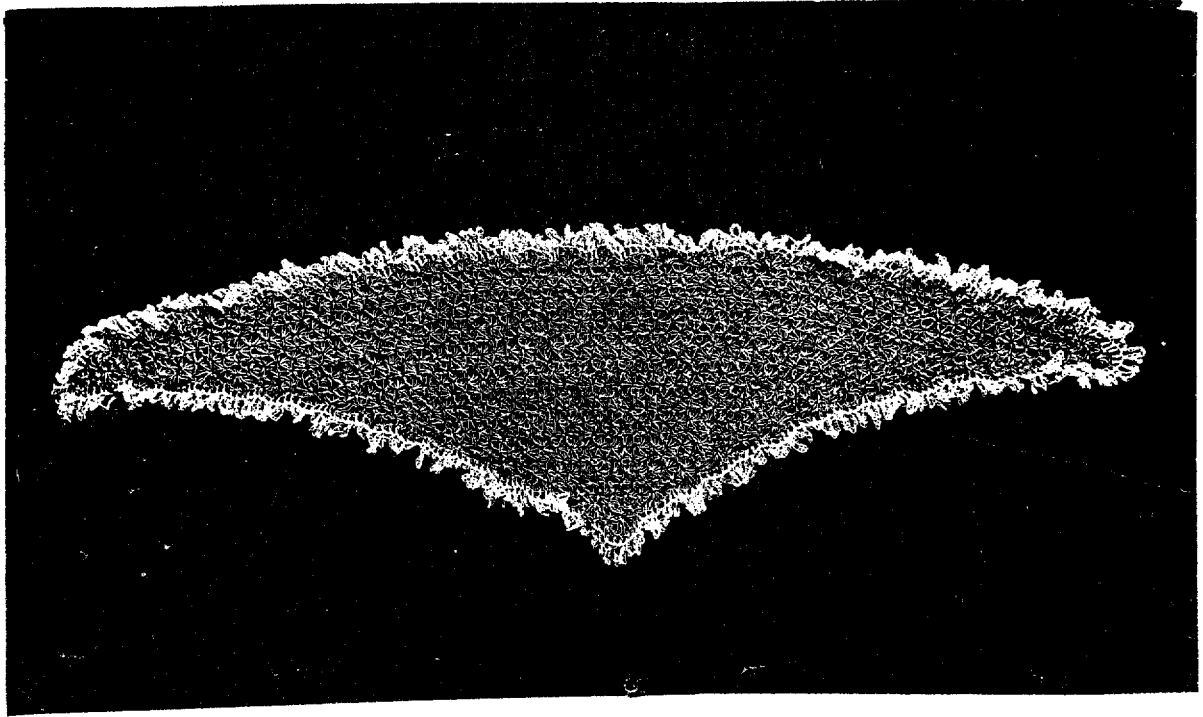

DESIGN FOR CROCHETED HOOD.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,847**, dated October 1, 1878; application filed August 12, 1878.
[Term of patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, EMMA M. ACKERMAN, of Boston, State of Massachusetts, have produced a new Combination Design for a Crocheted Hood or Tie for the Head or Neck, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification, which fully represents the nature of my combination design.

The body A of this hood or tie is composed of wool or worsted thread crocheted with stitch B, as shown in the body of the hood or tie, composed of two or more threads of contrast-

ing colors; also, the border or edges crocheted with the stitch C, representing lace-work as applied to the hood or tie as a fringe.

I claim—

The design for a hood or tie, consisting of stitches composed of two or more threads of contrasting or shaded colors, as shown in the body A, in combination with the fringe C, as described.
