## DESIGN FOR CARPETING.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,849**, dated October 1, 1878; application filed July 26, 1878.

[Term of patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, EUGÈNE PETIT, of the city of Paris, France, have invented or produced a new and original Design for a Pattern to be Inwrought into Axminster and other Carpeting similar to the photographs accompanying this specification; and I do hereby declare that the photographs accompanying this specification do give and convey to any one skilled in the art of carpet-weaving a defined and thorough description of the nature of my inven-

tion, that is sufficient to enable any one skilled in the art of carpet-weaving to use my invention.
