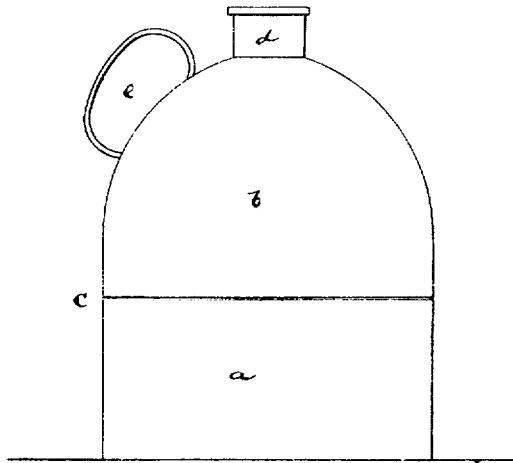

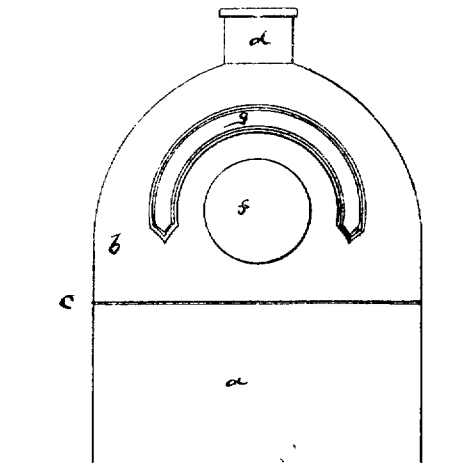

SIGMUND BELMONT, OF NEW ORLEANS, LOUISIANA.

## DESIGN FOR CIGAR-BOXES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,854**, dated October 1, 1878; application filed August 27, 1878.  
[Term of patent 7 years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, SIGMUND BELMONT, of the city of New Orleans, in the parish of Orleans and State of Louisiana, have invented a new and original Design for a Cigar-Box, of which the following is a specification:

In the drawing, Figure 1 represents a side elevation of my newly-designed cigar-box. Fig. 2 is a front view of the same.

Similar letters of reference indicate corresponding parts in both figures.

This invention relates to a new design for a cigar-box.

It consists in making the box in two parts,

*a b*, which form a line, *c*, at their junction. The part *a* is made cylindrical, while the part *b* is made cylindrical at the bottom, but hemispherical at the top. The part *b* is also provided with a projection, *d*, and scroll *e*. It likewise contains a circular ornamentation, *f*, and semi-annular scroll *g*, as shown.

I claim—
