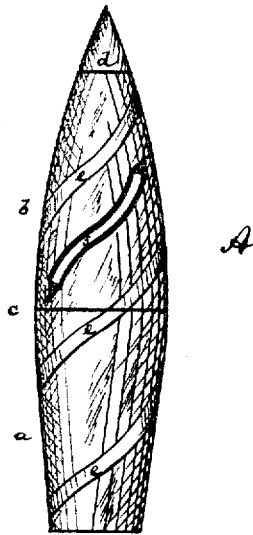

DESIGN FOR CIGAR-BOXES.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,855**, dated October 1, 1878; application filed August 27, 1878.
[Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, SIGMUND BELMONT, of New Orleans, in the parish of Orleans and State of Louisiana, have invented a new and original Design for a Cigar-Box, of which the following is a specification:

The drawing represents a side elevation of my newly-designed cigar-box.

This invention relates to a new design for a cigar-box; and consists in making the box A of two parts, *a b*, the part *a* being of trun-

cated conical form, while the part *b* is of conical form, and forms a line, *c*, with the part *b*. The box A is also ornamented by a tip, *d*, a spiral stripe, *e*, and a fancy scroll, *f*, as shown.

I claim—

The design for a cigar-box, substantially as shown.
