DESIGN FOR A CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,870**, dated October 15, 1878; application filed September 10, 1878.

[Term of patent 3½ years.]

Specification describing a new and original
Design for a Carpet, invented by CHARLES
MAGEE, of Brooklyn, county of Kings, and
State of New York.

This invention relates to a new and original
design for a carpet, oil-cloth, or similar fabric;
and it consists of a new arrangement and orna-
mentation of figures in the body and in the
border of the carpet, as hereinafter described.

In the photographic illustration, which rep-
resents a face view of my newly-designed car-
pet, the letter *a* is an irregular shield-like fig-
ure surrounded by a border and embellished
by floral decoration. *bb* are two figures of dif-
ferent ground color than the shield *a*, and ar-
ranged at opposite sides diagonally of such
shields. Both figures *bb* are irregular and
made of the same design. *cc* are tassel-like

ornaments arranged beneath the several figures
a. The carpet is embellished by the represen-
tation of bouquets *d* and by other floral orna-
mentations. The border of the carpet con-
tains an inner plain stripe, *f*, and outer zigzag
stripe, *g*, having inwardly-projecting semicir-
cular ornaments *h*. Between the stripes *f* and
g are representations of shields resembling the
shields *a*, and floral decorations that extend
over the stripe *f*, as shown. The tassel-like
ornaments *c* are also in the border.

I claim—

The design for a carpet, substantially as
shown.
