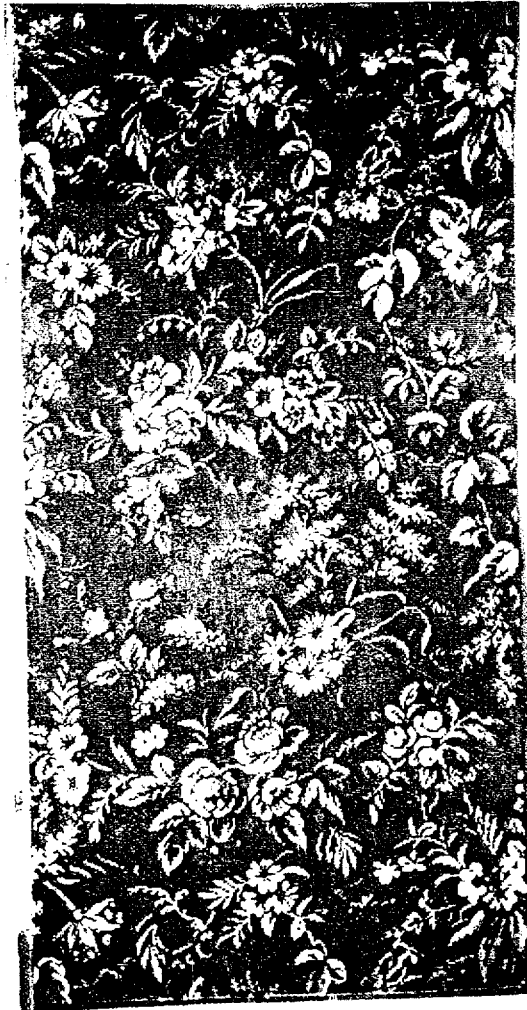

## DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,874**, dated October 22, 1878; application filed October 1, 1878.  
[Term of patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, JOHN MAGEE, of Brooklyn, Kings county, New York, have invented a new and original Design for a Carpet, of which the following is a specification:

This invention relates to a new design for a carpet, oil-cloth, or similar fabric.
