

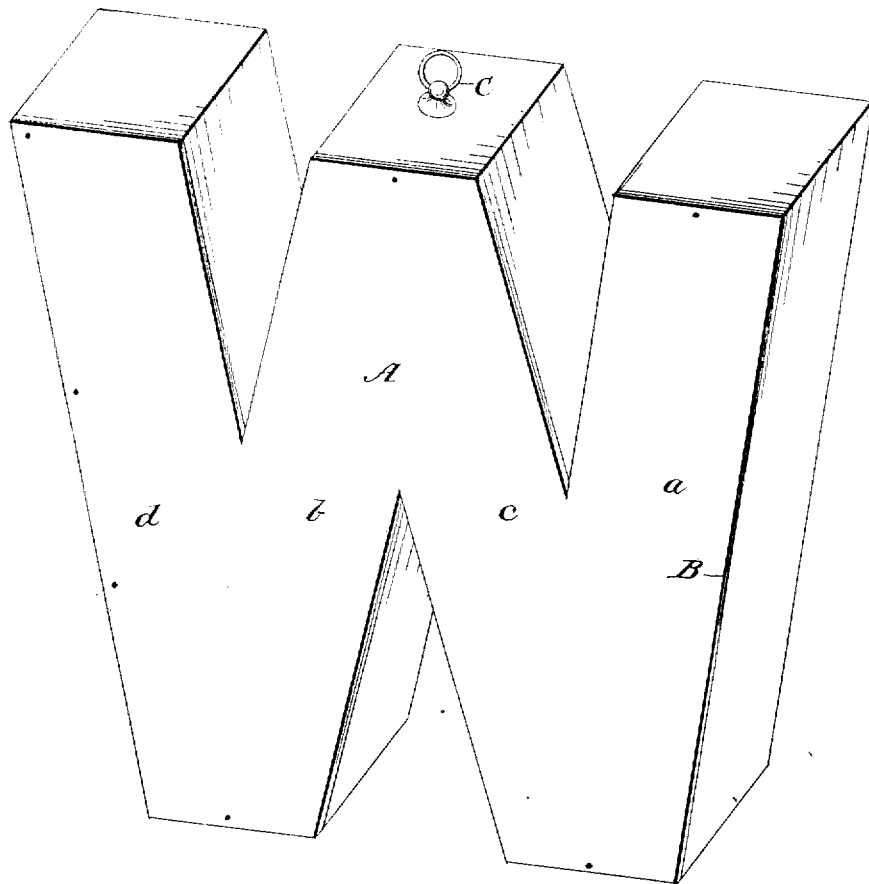

DESIGN FOR A BOX.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,886**, dated October 29, 1878; application filed October 17, 1878.
[Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, MICHAEL I. WELLER, of Washington, District of Columbia, have originated and invented a new and useful Design for Boxes for Cigars, &c.; and I do hereby declare that the following is a full, clear, and exact description thereof, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part of this specification.

My design has for its object to furnish to the trade a peculiarly-shaped box for the packing of cigars and other merchandise; and it consists in a box formed in the shape of a letter **W**.

The letter **A** represents a box, constructed of any suitable material, or a combination of materials, and which is composed of two parallel sections, *a b*, inclined in one direction, and connected to two similar parallel sections,

c d, inclined in an opposite direction, the whole forming a block letter **W**. The letter **B** represents the cover, and **C** a ring by which the box may be suspended.

The box forms quite a novel and striking design, and is intended for the purpose of exposing cigars and other merchandise in the show windows and cases, and elsewhere.

I claim as my invention—

The design for a box substantially as shown and described.
