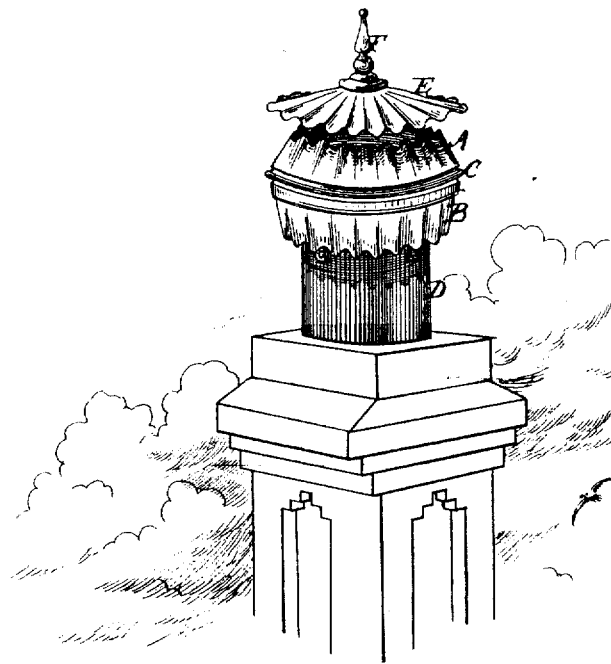

DESIGN FOR CHIMNEY-CAPS AND VENTILATORS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,895**, dated November 5, 1878; application filed October 18, 1878.
[Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, DWIGHT B. RICH, of Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have originated a new Design in Chimney-Caps and Ventilators, of which the following is a specification:

My design is represented in the accompanying drawing, in which A B represent two conical frusta joined together at their larger diameters by an intervening bead or ring, C. The two parts or frusta are fluted or corrugated toward their smaller diameters, as shown, the upper and lower edges of the same presenting a scalloped appearance. Surmounting the main portion, A B, is a cover, E, which is also fluted or corrugated, as shown, and presenting scalloped edges. On the top of the cover E is a point or pinnacle, F, as shown.

I do not claim the construction of the frusta and cap aside from the particular configuration shown; but

What I claim as my invention is—

A design for a chimney-cap and ventilator, consisting of the fluted or corrugated frusta A B, the bead C, and the fluted cover E, substantially as shown and described.
