

DESIGN FOR PULLS FOR DRAWERS, &c.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,920, dated November 19, 1878; application filed November 8, 1878.

[Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE W. TUCKER, of Waterbury, New Haven county, Connecticut, have invented or produced a Design for Pulls for Drawers, &c., of which the following is the specification:

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying drawing, to which refer-

ence is made.

A is the plate or shield, having the outline shown serrated at the upper edge x, having a stud, a, and ornamented on the face by a representation of a saddle, p. To a cross-bar, i, connected to the stud a, or passing through the same, is attached the handle B, made in the form of a horseshoe, and ornamented by indentations t, as shown.

I claim-

1. The design for the plate a, having the

form of a shield with serrations x at the top, substantially as shown.

2. The design for the plate A, having the stud a, and ornamented by the representation of a saddle, b, substantially as shown.

3. The design for the ornamental handle B, having the form of a horseshoe with indentations t, substantially as specified.

4. The design for a pull having the shield A, ornamented as shown, and handle B, in the form of a horseshoe, suspended from the stud a, and ornamented as shown.
