

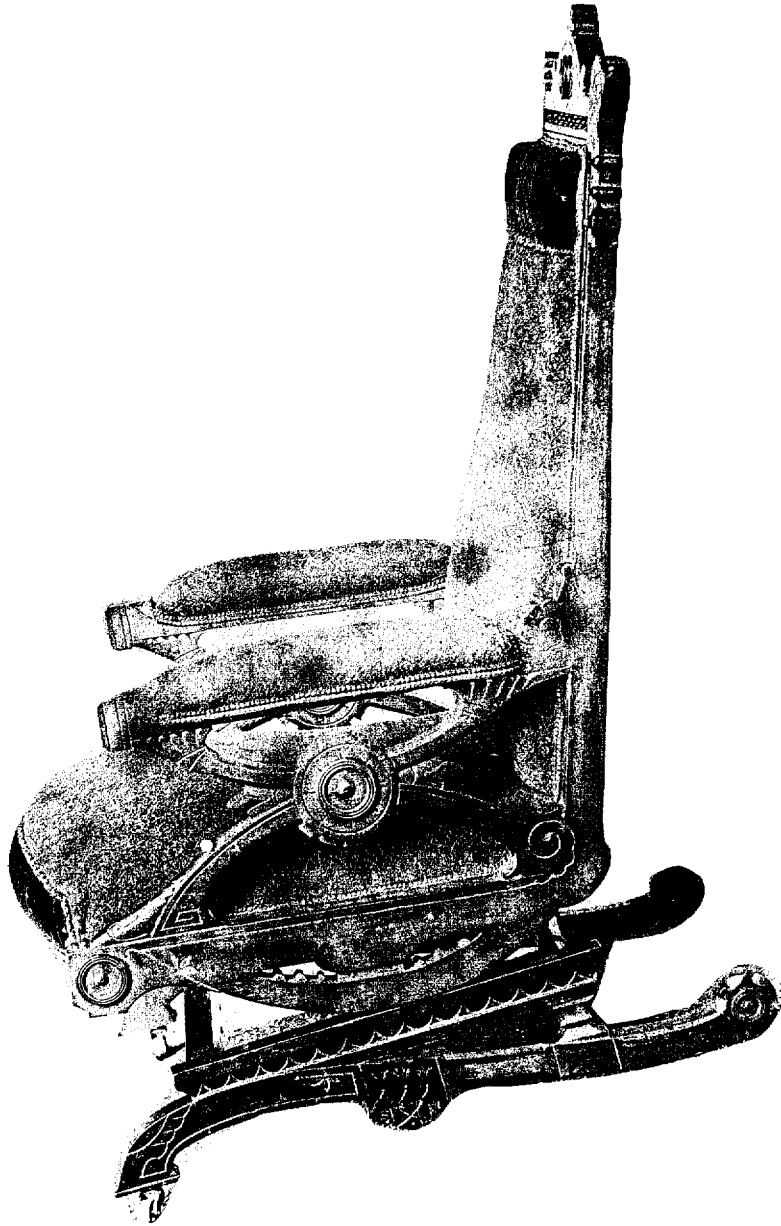

## DESIGN FOR ROCKING-CHAIRS.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,924**, dated November 26, 1878; application filed October 4, 1878.  
[Term of patent  $3\frac{1}{2}$  years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, EUGENE A. FUCHS, of Brooklyn, E. D., county of Kings, and State of New York, have originated a Design for Rocking-Chairs, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification.

My invention relates to a design for the seat-frame and for the base or supporting frame of rocking-chairs.

It consists, as to the seat-frame, of a rectilinear arm, A, a rectilinear sill, B, carrying the rocker C, and of intermediate arches D E, which are joined together at their apexes, and joined at their ends, respectively, to the arm and to the sill. At their point of contact the arches D E are covered by a rosette, F.

It consists, as to the base-frame, of an ogee-shaped bottom rail, G, and a rectilinear top rail, H. The top rail, H, rests on the bottom rail at its forward end, and is joined thereto by a baluster, I, at its rear end.

The parts of both the seat-frame and the base-frame are ornamented, as shown; but this ornamentation does not form any essential feature of my design.

What I claim as my invention is—

1. The design for the seat-frame of rocking-chairs, consisting of a rectilinear arm, A, a rectilinear sill, B, carrying the rocker, and of intermediate arches D E, as herein described, and shown in the accompanying photographic illustration.

2. The design for the base-frame of rocking-chairs consisting of an ogee-shaped bottom rail, G, and a rectilinear top rail, H, as herein described, and shown in the accompanying photographic illustration.
