

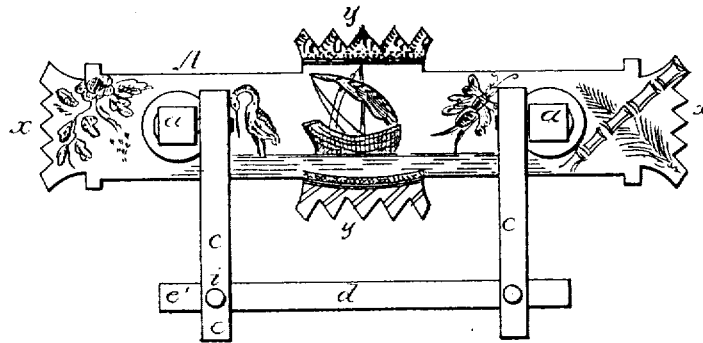

DESIGN FOR PULLS FOR DRAWERS, &c.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,928**, dated November 26, 1878; application filed November 8, 1878.
[Term of patent 7 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, GEORGE W. TUCKER, of Waterbury, New Haven county, Connecticut, have invented or produced a Design for Pulls for Drawers, &c., of which the following is a specification:

The nature of my design is fully shown in the accompanying drawing, to which reference is made.

A is the shield or plate, having parallel sides, serrated ends $x x$, central projections $y y$, and studs a .

The face of the plate is ornamented as shown, or in any other suitable manner. The handle B is suspended between the studs a , and consists of the rectangular parallel bars $c c$ and cross-bars d , the ends $e e'$ of the bars projecting, as shown.

I claim—

1. The design for the plate A, having serrated ends and projections $x y$, substantially as shown.

2. The design for the plate A, ornamented as set forth.

3. The design for the handle B, consisting of rectangular parallel bars $c c$ and cross-bars d , substantially as set forth.
