

DESIGN FOR COOKING-RANGES.

Specification forming part of Design No. 10,940, dated December 3, 1878; application filed November 15, 1878.

[Term of patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that we, NICHOLAS S. VEDDER, of the city of Troy, in the county of Rensselaer and State of New York, and Tobias S. Heister, of Lausingburg, in said county and State, have jointly invented and produced a new and original ornamental Design for Cooking-Ranges, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying cut, print, or engraving of a cooking-range embodying our said new design.

One part of this invention is the design for the outer portion of the side doors A B C D E, composed of the oblique, rectangular, zigzag fillet ornamentation f along the outer sides; the rectangular corner-pieces g, having the cruciform ornaments h; the convex molding i; and the inner ornamental molding, consisting of the compound side fillets, j, and the projecting corner-pieces k, having thereon the trifid ornaments l, all shaped and arranged together so as to present substantially the same appearance as is represented in the aforesaid print.

Another part of this invention is the design

for the panel M, consisting of the border composed of the above-specified parts j, k, and l; the matted surface n; and the compound central ornament, consisting of the broad lanceolate leaves p, the terminal leaves, q, and the five-pointed floral representations r, all shaped and disposed substantially as shown in the aforesaid cut.

What we claim as our invention is-

1. The design for the outer portion of the side doors, consisting of the parts f, g h, i, j and k l, shaped and arranged together as described.

2. The design for the panel M, composed of the parts j k l, n, and p q r, shaped and arranged together as set forth.
