DESIGN FOR A SLEEVELESS CROCHETED JACKET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,973**, dated December 17, 1878; application filed October 26, 1878.
[Term of patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN HOLMES, of Boston, in the county of Suffolk and State of Massachusetts, have originated and designed a Crocheted Jacket, of which the following is a full, clear, and exact description, reference being had to the accompanying photographic illustration, making part of this specification.

The nature of my design is fully represented in the accompanying photographic illustration, to which reference is made.

The body A. of the jacket is composed of worsted or wool yarn, crocheted to form shell-like stitches *a*.

The lower end of the jacket is trimmed with a series of crocheted loops, *b*, arranged close together to form a fringe all about the bottom of the jacket.

The fringe-forming material is made by en-

chaining one loop after another by one needle, thereby making a knitted strand or cord, which is, at suitable intervals, connected in loop form with the lower end of the jacket.

I claim—

The design for a jacket consisting of the crocheted shell-stitch body portion and the looped crocheted border upon the skirt or lower edge of the jacket, as described, and shown in the accompanying photographic illustration.
