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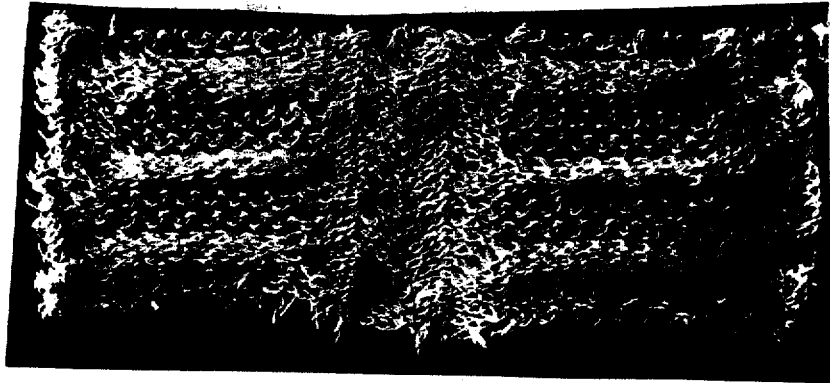

## DESIGN FOR KNITTED FABRIC.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,979**, dated January 7, 1879; application filed December 7, 1878.  
[Term of patent 2½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, CORNELIUS JACKSON, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for Knitted Fabric, of which the following is a specification:

My design is shown in the accompanying photographic illustration.

The design comprises alternating portions *a* and *b*, the portion *a* being plain, and the portion *b* having a groundwork of a somewhat more loosely-knitted character than the portion *a*, which groundwork is crossed at intervals by puffed or raised stripes *d*.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—

The design for a knitted fabric, said design comprising the plain portions *a* and striped portions *b*, all substantially as shown and described.
