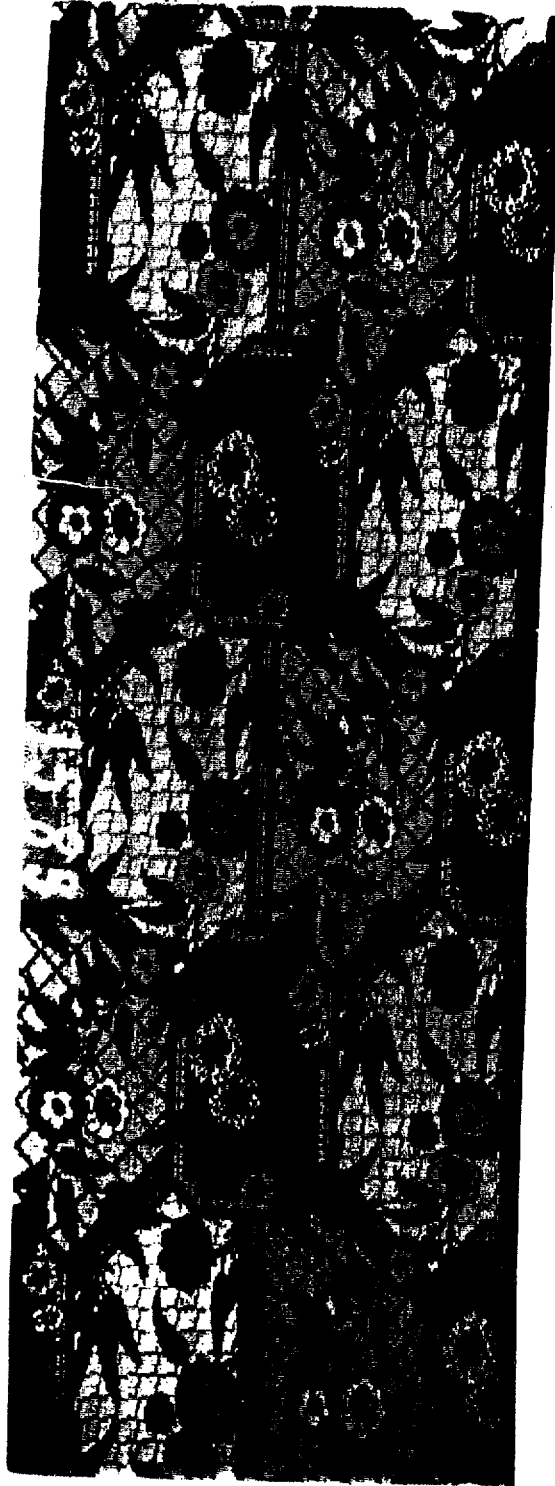

DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **10,987**, dated January 21, 1879; application filed December 23, 1878.
[Term of patent 3½ years.]
