DESIGN FOR KNITTED FRINGE.

Specification forming part of Design No. 11,015, dated February 4, 1879; application filed December 7, 1878. [Term of patent 34 years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HENRY A. TRUITT, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Knitted Fringe, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a knitted fringe is shown in

the accompanying photographic illustration.

My design comprises, essentially, a tufted heading, A, and pendent tassels B.

The heading may have but one row of tufts, a, as shown in Fig. 1; or two rows of tufts, a, as shown in Fig. 2, may be used; or even more than two rows may be employed in some cases. The size of the tassel and the form of the top of the same may also be varied without de-

parting from the distinctive character of the design.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim-The design for a knitted fringe, said design comprising a tufted heading, A, and pendent tassels B, all substantially as shown and described.
