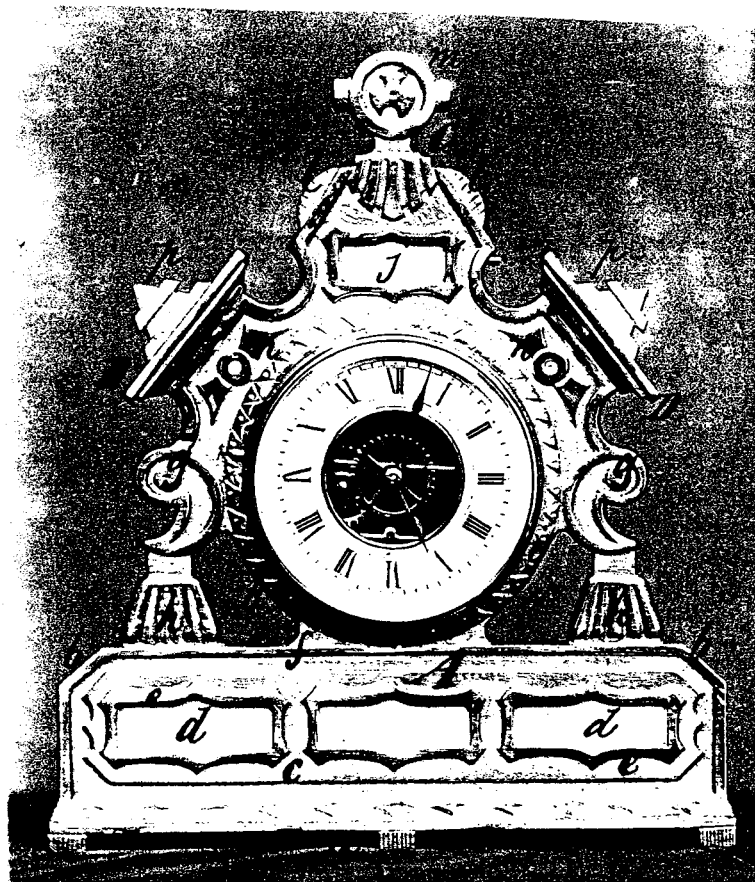

## DESIGN FOR BASE AND FRONT OF A CLOCK.

Specification forming part of Design No. **11,021**, dated February 11, 1879; application filed January 18, 1879.  
[Term of patent 7 years.]

### *To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, HENRY R. FRISBIE, of Bridgeport, in the county of Fairfield and State of Connecticut, have invented a new and original Design for the Base and Front of a Clock, of which the following is a description:

The form of the base A is oblong. It has on the lower part of its front an ornamental molding, *a*, and its top and ends are surmounted by a bead, *b*.

A raised panel, *c*, extends nearly the whole length of the base, and has within it three smaller panels, *d*, surmounted by ornamental raised moldings *e*.

The front of the clock rests upon the base at *f*, and has scroll ornaments *g g* at each side of the circular portion B surrounding the face, which terminates in detached feet *h h*. The said circular portion has an ornamental dog-tooth molding, *i*, surrounding the face.

C is a projection extending upwardly from the circular portion B, and D D are projections extending radially from said circular portion at each side of the projection C.

The projection C has upon its face a panel, *j*, surrounded by a raised molding, and its sides are inclined and joined to the projections D D by curves. The inclined sides have ornaments *l*, and a finial ornament, *m*, surmounts the whole.

The projections D D have upon their faces raised ornaments *n*, and are surmounted by molded caps *o* and pyramidal ornaments *p*.

### I claim—

1. The design for the base of a clock comprising the ornamented molding *a*, bead *b*, panels *c d*, and moldings *e*, substantially as herein described, and shown in the accompanying photographic illustrations.

2. The design for a clock-front comprising the circular portion B, scroll ornaments *g g*, detached feet *h h*, projection C, and projections D D, substantially as herein described, and shown in the accompanying photographic illustrations.

3. The design for a clock-front comprising the circular portion B, scroll ornaments *g g*, detached feet *h h*, projection C, and projections D D, with the molding *i*, panel *j*, molded caps *o*, and ornaments *l m n p*, substantially as herein described, and shown in the accompanying photographic illustrations.

4. The design for a base and clock front comprising the ornamental molding *a*, bead *b*, panels *c d*, and moldings *e*, and the circular portion B, scroll ornaments *g g*, detached feet *h h*, projection C, and projections D D, with the molding *i*, panel *j*, molded caps *o*, and ornaments *l m n p*, substantially as herein described, and shown in the accompanying photographic illustrations.
