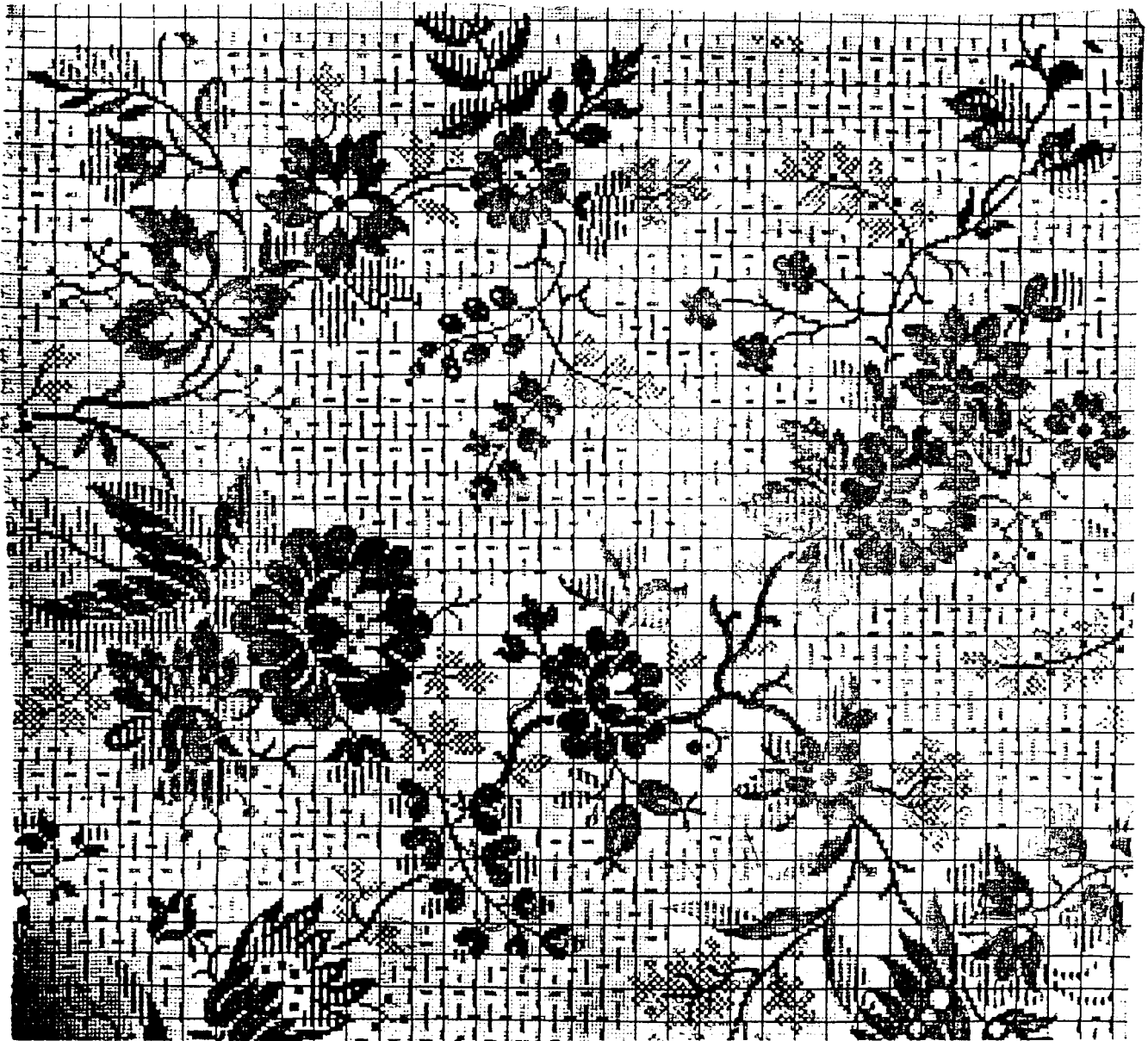

## DESIGN FOR CARPET-PATTERN.

Specification forming part of Design No. **11,022**, dated February 11, 1879; application filed January 18, 1879.  
[Term of patent 3½ years.]

*To all whom it may concern:*

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new and original Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a specification:

My design for a carpet-pattern is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration.

The design is of a foliated character; and consists of stems *a*, leaves *b*, blossoms or buds *d*, and flowers *e*, the spaces of the groundwork intervening between the floral or foliated parts of the design being filled with oblong spots *i*, as clearly shown in the illustration.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim—  
The design for a carpet-pattern, said design consisting of stems, leaves, buds, and flowers, all substantially as described, and as shown in and by the accompanying photographic illustration.
