

DESIGN FOR CARPET-PATTERN.

Specification forming part of Design No. 11,047, dated March 4, 1879; application filed January 18, 1879. [Term of patent 3½ years.]

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, ALFRED HEALD, of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have produced or invented a new and original Design for a Carpet-Pattern, of which the following is a speci-

My design for a carpet-pattern is fully shown in the accompanying photographic illustration.

The design comprises four square figures,

A, B, D, and E, arranged as shown.

The figures A and E are alike, each containing scroll-like stems on a mottled ground.

The figure B is crossed diagonally by a band, a, the space on both sides of this band being filled in with square and oblong figures, spots, and stripes, in a manner too clearly shown to need minute description.

The figure D is likewise crossed diagonally by a band, b, and the space on both sides of this figure is filled with spots, stripes, and other ornaments of a character clearly shown in the illustration.

Irrespective of the colors employed, I claim-1. The design for a carpet-pattern, comprising the diagonal band a and the spots, stripes, and other ornaments on both sides of the said band, as shown and described.

2. The design for a carpet-pattern, comprising the diagonal band b and the stripes, spots, and other ornaments, as shown and described.

3. The design for a carpet-pattern, comprising the figures A, B, D, and E, as shown and described.
