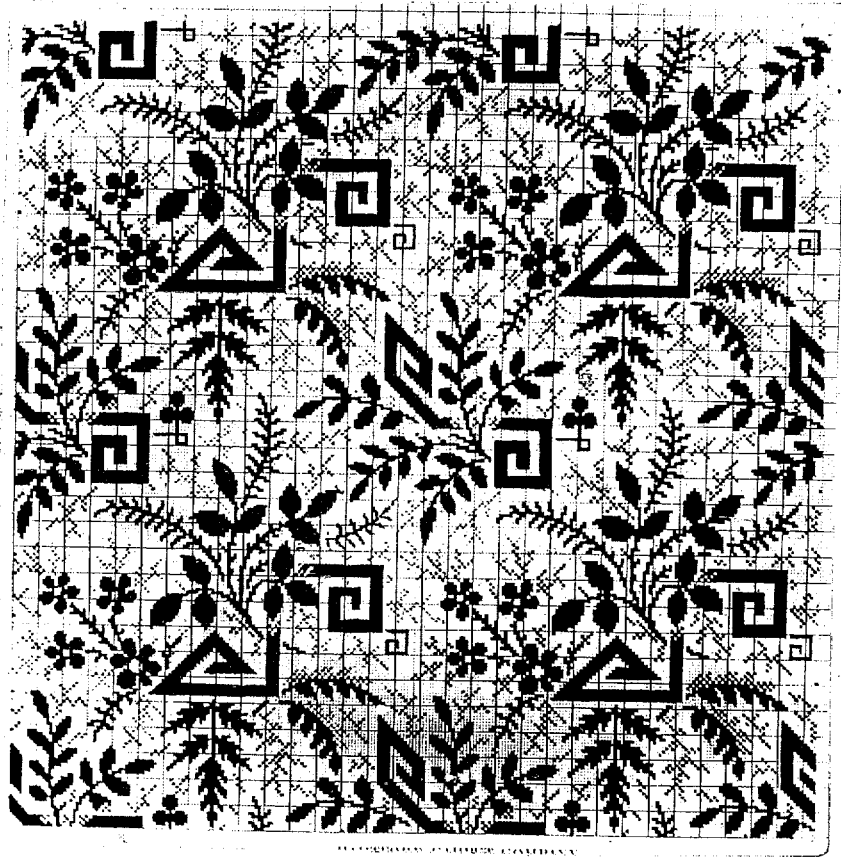

## DESIGN FOR CARPET.

Specification forming part of Design No. **11,081**, dated March 25, 1879; application filed February 28, 1879.
