He also said, in an oral statement to Ambassador Briggs, that the signing of an armistice "will mean the automatic with-drawal of South Korean forces from the UN Command."

Comment: Since South Korean troops occupy virtually 70 percent of the present battle line, this decision by Rhee could produce incidents during the period of implementation of the truce terms which would seriously jeopardize the UN political and military position. The attitude of the army thus becomes critical at this point since it is not known whether the present ranking military commanders, who are under UN operational control, will abide by Rhee's decision.
