MEMORANDUM FOR MR. HUNDT

In a conversation with Henry Rowen, Colonel Armstrong, also of USA, and Henry Kissinger, on Friday, I discussed the initial response of the Joint Chiefs to the request for military plans in connection with Berlin (DCSM 430 and 431). It is clear that the "general war" which the JCS discussed is exactly the one-shot response with all our nuclear forces envisioned in SIOP 62.

The planning for several alternative limited target lists which might be relevant to the Berlin crisis has not begun. Rowen is drafting a request for such planning, a copy of which I expect to receive, but I think this should be considered as an urgent matter at higher levels.
