

COMPROMISE REACHED BETWEEN THE CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATION AND THE SOVIET LEADERS IN MOSCOW WHICH IT SAYS IT LEARNED ON SUNDAY.

IT REPORTS THAT IT WAS DECIDED IN MOSCOW, AMONG OTHER THINGS,

THAT ALL ACTS AGAINST OCCUPATION TROOPS ARE TO BE DISCONTINUED ON THE CZECHOSLOVAK SIDE. THE COUNTRY IS TO STAY IN THE WARSAW PACT.

FREEDOM OF PRESS AND RADIO IS TO BE CURTAILED. ALL ARRESTED PERSONS ARE TO BE RELEASED. BESIDES, IT HAS BEEN AGREED THAT ALL OCCUPATION TROOPS WILL STAY IN THE COUNTRY UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.
