(TEXT) A REPORT HAS BEEN RECEIVED FROM THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY :
A DEPUTY HAS ARRIVED AND HAS STATED THAT HE HAS BEEN AUTHORIZED
TO ANNOUNCE THAT THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY IS IN SESSION
IN A CROWDED HOUSE. TWO DOCUMENTS HAVE BEEN ADOPTED:

FIRST, A LETTER IS TO BE SENT TO THE FOREIGN COUNTRIES ASKING
THEM TO WITHDRAW THEIR FORCES; SECOND, THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY STANDS
BEHIND THE POLICY OF DUBCEK AND BEHIND PRESIDENT SVOBODA.

IN FRONT OF THE NATIONAL ASSEMBLY SOME 800 PEOPLE ARE DEMONSTRATING.
TANKS ARE APPROACHING . THERE ARE DEBATES WITH OCCUPATION SOLDIERS .
MARCHERS HAVE BEEN ALLOWED TO PROCEED IN THE DIRECTION OF THE
MAIN RAILWAY STATION.
