PRAGUE, CZECHOSLOVAKIA, AUG. 21 (REUTERS) -- A A STORM OF ANTI-RUSSIAN PROTEST SWEPT CZECHOSLOVAKIA TONIGHT IN THE WAKE OF RUSSIAN INVASION.

PRAGUE APPEARED ON THE BRINK OF BLOODY STRIFE AS FOUR PERSONS WERE SHOT AND KILLED AND 180 WOUNDED IN CLASHES WITH RUSSIAN TROOPS IN THE CAPITAL.

THE CZECHOSLOVAK NATIONAL ASSEMBLY CALLED ON SOVIET TROOPS TO WITHDRAW AND DENOUNCED THE OCCUPATION AS "A COMPLETE VIOLATION MF CZECHOSLOVAK SOVEREIGNTY."

AT THE SAME TIME IT URGED CZECHOSLOVAKS NOT TO RESORT TO VIOLENCE AGAINST THE OCCUPATION TROOPS, AN ACT WHICH IT SAID THE RUSSIANS MIGHT USE TO JUSTIFY THEIR INTERVENTION.

IT HINTED THAT THEY MIGHT DEMONSTRATE THEIR OPPOSITION

BY STAGING A GENERAL STRIKE.

ANOTHER DECLARATION SIGNED BY 11 MINISTERS IN THE DUBCEK GOVERNMENT PROCLIAMED FULL SUPPORT FOR THE NATIONS LEGALLY-ELECTED CONSTITUTIONAL AND POLITICAL BODIES.

"WE CONSIDER THE OCCUPATION OF CZECHOSLOVAKIA, CARRIED OUT WITHOUTHTHE AGREEMENT AND KNOWLEDGE OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT, AS AN ILLEGAL ACT AT VARIANCE WITH INTERNATIONAL LAW AND THE PRINCIPLES OF SOCIALIST INTERNATIONALISM," THE DECLARATION SAID.

NEITHER DUBCEK NOR OTHER TOP MEMBERS OF HIS GOVERNMENT WERE AMONG THE SIGNATORIES, INDICCATING THEY WERE ISOLATED FROM THEIR COLLEAGUES.
