Summary: Most articles these past weeks were about funding. Focused on DW plus-up now before House authorizing and appropriating committees. At issue is \$202m plus-up of \$500m FY04 mark, for total DW amount of \$702 million, or less.
6/12/03 - House Authorizers marked to \$702, House Appropriators marked to \$530 (+\$30 million Eagle Eye funding earmarked)

Op Ed by Jim Saxton (The Hill) in favor of additional funding. Several articles on the unsatisfactory impression of port security (not specifically Deepwater, but CG ability to monitor port traffic and security) and funds funneling through DHS to local first responders.

Trade Show Booth

- 3. **Domestic tradeshows for 2004**: Navy League (April), AFCEA (April/May?), NDIA CG Innovation Expo (May). Likely to decline SNA and should consider ASNE. Final list to be discussed and finalized for FY04.
