DETENTION ORDER

BEFORE U.S. MAGISTRATE JUDGE BYRON G. CUDMORE:

On September 24, 2009, a detention hearing was requested by the Government in the above listed cause. On order of a Court of the United States, or on request of an attorney for the government, the person in charge of the corrections facility shall deliver the Defendant to the U.S. Marshal for the purpose of an appearance in connection with a court proceeding herein.
