GOVERNMENT'S MOTION TO UNSEAL, CORRECT, AND RESEAL INDICTMENT AND ARREST WARRANT

The United States of America hereby moves to correct in form but not in substance the sealed indictment and an arrest warrant in this case, and states:

- 1. The Indictment and an arrest warrant issued in this case refers to D-7 as "THOMAS EDWARD PIATEK".
 - 2. D-7's middle name should read "WILLIAM."
- 3. The evidence presented before the Grand Jury included an exhibit containing two photographs of THOMAS WILLIAM PIATEK, including a photograph taken from his Indiana Driver's License. It further included the sworn testimony of a law enforcement officer that the person pictured therein is the person known by a Cooperating Witness and an undercover FBI agent to be the person who participated in the criminal violations contained in the Indictment.
- 4. As the result of a scrivener's error, the middle name "EDWARD" was inadvertently used in the Indictment instead of the correct middle name of "WILLIAM". This same error was repeated in the arrest warrant issued subsequent to the presentment of the Indictment.

WHEREFORE, the government requests this Court to issue an order permitting the unsealing of the Indictment in this case and the arrest warrant solely for the purpose of correcting this error. The government further requests that the corrected Indictment and Arrest Warrant, as well as this motion and the court order then be immediately resealed.


