- a. Location: Fort Ritchie, MD.
- b. Confidential Source Utilization: Three confidential sources.
- c. Information Obtained or Reported on Non-Affiliated Civilians: None.
- d. Useful Information Obtained:

(1) During the reporting period, adverse suitability information (indebtedness, drug or alcohol abuse, moral improprieties and mental instability) was reported concerning 17 individuals assigned sensitive duties. Monitoring continues; a limited investigation has been requested on one of the individuals.

(2) This ICIP had previously identified alleged users of narcotics. As a result of an investigation conducted by USACIDC, 13 of these individuals were apprehended and charged with drug violations. Eleven of these 13 had security clearances and had access to the Alternate Joint Command Center.

e. Operational Status:

(1) On 18 December, the Project Liaison Officer (PLO) presented a Quarterly Progress Report to the Commander, US Army Communications Command (USACC). On 30 December 1975, the PLO presented the Quarterly Progress Report to the Commander, Fort Ritchie; Commander, USACC Site R Telecommunications Center; and the Deputy ACSI&S, 7th Signal Command. All expressed appreciation and continued support for the ICIP.

(2) At the request of the Director, Administrative Services, JCS, the portion of this operation in support of the Alternate National Military Command Center was terminated.
