Based on the government's consent motion to modify the Order to seal and the defendant's release conditions, the defendant's consent to the motion, and the entire record in this matter, it is 1614 day of June, 2009 hereby

ORDERED that the government's consent motion to modify the Order to seal and the defendant's release conditions is **GRANTED**. It is further

ORDERED that the government may disclose the Information, plea agreement and statement of offense filed in this matter to the following agencies for purposes of allowing them to make appropriate security decisions concerning the defendant: NASA's Office of Security and Program Protection; the Defense Security Service; and the Naval Acquisition Integrity Office. In connection with any such disclosure, the government shall inform those agencies that the documents provided to them remain under seal and may not be disclosed within or outside the agencies except as necessary to make appropriate security determinations concerning the defendant. It is further

ORDERED that the defendant shall surrender any and all of his passports to his counsel, Bradford A. Berenson, Esquire, Sidley Austin LLP, 1501 K Street, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20005, within ten days of this Order. It is further



ORDERED that the defendant shall obtain prior Court approval (with notice to the United States Attorney's Office for the District of Columbia) prior to traveling internationally, retrieving his passport from counsel, seeking to replace his passport or obtaining a new passport.
