1. MfS Bezirksverwaltung (BV) Headquarters in KARL MARX STADT (UEA36)
(formerly CHEMNITZ) East Germany:

a. The MfS BV office for KARL MARX STADT is located at Hohe Strasse 35 in an administration type U-shaped building, which was formerly the CHEMNITZ Finance Office during World War II (See Exhibit I). Hohe Strasse is located in the District of Kasseberg to the west of the center of the city. Across the street is a small park and open area. To the left of the MfS compound at 37-39 Hohe Strasse is the Soviet Military Headquarters. The MfS Compound is located in a city square with Hohe Strasse on the east, Henrietten Strasse (formerly Franz Seldte Strasse) on the north, Kasseberg Strasse on the west, and West Strasse on the south (See Exhibit II). The compound consists of two buildings with an iron picket fence 6 feet high surrounding the area. The fence running along the front of the building on the Hohe Strasse side is approximately 230 feet long. The only gate for entry for autos and personnel is located at the extreme left end of the compound. The main administration building is three stories high with a completed attic floor. The ground floor is constructed of natural stone and the remaining floors are made of grey stucco finishing. The building itself is approximately 200 feet long in the front and 85 feet on the side. The width of each of the side wings is approximately 50 feet. On the roof of this building are two radio antennas each about 35 feet tall. The other building in the compound appears to be a barracks or living quarters for personnel. It is a two-story high stone building and has no windows on the rear wall (See Exhibit II). The grounds of the compound are patrolled by guards and watchdogs.

b. The central switchboard exchange number of MfS BV Karl Marx Stadt is 3 05 55.

c. One block to the rear of the MfS BV compound on Henrietten Strasse corner of Kasseberg Strasse is another small compound consisting of two 2-story buildings each of which are approximately 80 feet by 60 feet in size (See Exhibit II). The buildings are of modern style and appear to have been recently built. A guard at the entrance on Kasseberg Strasse wears the uniform of the MfS Guard Regiment. Source could not determine the Department or Office quartered in this compound.

2. MfS Kreisdienststelle (KD) in KARL MARX STADT, East Germany:

Approximately three blocks south of the MfS BV at Reichs Strasse 17 is the MfS KD. It is a four-story red brick building approximately 165 feet long and

An examination of files maintained by Region VIII, 66th CIC Group, APO 742, US Forces reveals several traces of the MFS BV in KARL MARX STADT at Hohe Strasse 35, reference SOI, file: EE-567243/e, Subject: EGIS-MFS Bezirk Chemnitz, dated 30 January 1959. The telephone number of this MFS BV has been reported in numerous SOIs. The MFS KD was previously reported to be on Gutenbergstrasse, KARL MARX STADT, reference SOI, file EE-567243/e, Subject EGIS-MFS Bezirk Chemnitz, dated 30 January 1959. The KD telephone number is listed in the Bezirk Karl Marx Stadt phone book, however, there is no record of this number being forwarded in a report.

In an effort to obtain current data on MfS installations in East Germany, this office dispatched Sources to the town of WURZEN, county seat of Kreis Wurzen, Bezirk Leipzig, East Germany. Sources were able to determine through discreet inquiry and personal observation the exact location and existence of the MfS Kreisdienststelle in that town. Sources were unable to describe the physical layout of the inside of the offices or of the personnel or activities.

1. MfS Kreisdienststelle (KD) at WURZEN US4393, East Germany: The Ministerium fuer Staatssicherheit (MfS) maintains a Kreisdienststelle in WURZEN at Dehnitzer Weg 2 in a house on the corner of Stephan Strasse. (See Exhibit "I"). The office is located approximately one block north and one block west of the railroad station. To the north of Dehnitzer Weg 2 is the Wurzenner Cartonagener Fabrik (Wurzen Carton Manufacturing Plant). To the east and approximately one short block away is the local Post Office. (See Exhibit "II"). This KD office is located in a two-story stucco villa set back approximately 26 feet from Dehnitzer Weg. Entrance to this office is on the center of the eastern side of the building. A one car garage, detached from the house, is situated in the northwest corner of the villa grounds. The plot of ground is approximately 45 feet square and is surrounded on all four sides with a seven foot wooden fence. At the time of the observation, a man in civilian clothes dressed in a leather jacket and a leading a Schaeferhund dog walked out into the street. The telephone number of the WURZEN KD is 21 32.

2. An examination of the files maintained by Region VIII, 66th CIC Group, APO 742, US Forces, revealed that the MfS office in WURZEN is located on Dehnitzer Weg, number unknown, reference SOI, Region VIII, File: D-567250/e, Subject: SFS District Leipzig, dated 1 November 1955. Three traces reveal the telephone number 21 32 as that of KD WURZEN; the latest reference reports this number as that of MfS agent b6. The Source of this information is b6, date of information is 20 August 1958 and is evaluated F-6.

a. Sachsenring, type P-70 (small East German Coupe vehicle), steel blue in color, with license number SV 11-49.

b. Sachsenring /Horch, with a spotlight on the right front body of car, dark in color, with license number SV 21-90.

c. IFA-F9, East German make vehicle, green in color, with license number SV 21-72.

d. BMW (Eisenacher Motoren Werke) with a spotlight on the front body and two way radio communication equipment installed within. The car was green in color with license number SB 45-24.

e. BMW, dark blue in color, with license number SV-59-95.

f. BMW, green in color, with license number SV 40-43. This auto had a man wearing a long leather overcoat sitting in the driver's seat.

g. BMW (Bayerischer Motoren Werke), green in color, with license number SB 84-01.
