References:

- a. Your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of March 29, 2001, for records concerning various dossiers.
- b. Our letter of April 20, 2001, informing you that additional time was needed to review the records and we were unable to comply the 20-day statutory time limit in processing your request.

We have conducted checks of the automated Defense Clearance and Investigations Index and a search of the Investigative Records Repository to determine the existence of Army intelligence investigative records responsive to your request.

We have located the enclosed records pertaining to Amman Jordan Espionage, ZF003045W. We have completed a mandatory declassification review in accordance with Executive Order (EO) 12958. As a result of our review, information has been sanitized from the records as it is currently and properly classified SECRET according to Sections 1.3(a)(2) and 1.5(c) of EO 12958. This information is exempt from the public disclosure provisions of the FOIA pursuant to Title 5 U.S. Code 552(b)(1). The records are enclosed for your use. Fees for processing this request are waived. A brief explanation of the applicable sections follows:

Section 1.3(a)(2) of EO 12958 provides that information shall be classified SECRET if its unauthorized disclosure reasonably could be expected to cause serious damage to the national security.

Section 1.5(c) of EO 12958 provides that information pertaining to intelligence activities, intelligence sources or methods, and cryptologic information shall be considered for classification protection.


Since the release of some of the information deleted from these records would result in an unwarranted invasion of the privacy rights of the individuals concerned, this information is exempt from the public disclosure provisions of the FOIA pursuant to Title 5 U.S. Code 552 (b)(6).

The withholding of information by this office is a partial denial of your request. This denial is made on behalf of Brigadier General Keith B. Alexander, the Commanding General, U.S. Army Intelligence and Security Command, who is the Initial Denial Authority for Army intelligence investigative and security records under the FOIA. You may appeal this decision to the Secretary of the Army. If you wish to file an appeal, you should forward it to this office. Your appeal must be postmarked no later than 60 calendar days from the date of this letter. After the 60 day period, the case may be considered closed; however, such closure does not preclude you filing litigation in the courts.

We are continuing to review records regarding other titles you have requested and will respond to you by separate correspondence when our review is complete.

SUBJECT: POSSIBLE SAEDA (U)

1. (S)(U) AT 1705 HOURS, 16 MAR 84, FOUR (4) AMERICAN SOLDIERS AND ONE (1) JORDANIAN SOLDIER WERE LEAVING THE MILITARY COMPOUND HOUSING THE JORDANIAN 101ST SPECIAL FORCES BATTALION WITH THE INTENTION OF GOING INTO AMMAN. AT AN INTERSECTION ABOUT ONE (1) MILE FROM THE 101ST SF BN COMPOUND, AN INDIVIDUAL IN A WHITE CHEVROLET CAMARO WITH BLACK TOP STOPPED TO PICK THEM UP FOR A RIDE INTO AMMAN. WHILE DRIVING INTO AMMAN, THIS INDIVIDUAL (SUBJECT) STATED QUOTE HE WAS A RUSSIAN AND COMMUNIST BUT THAT HE LIKED AMERICANS AND LIKED TO GET HIGH ON GRASS UNQUOTE. SUBJECT TOOK THE SOLDIERS TO A HOUSE IN AMMAN WITH A BAR REPORTEDLY WHERE SUBJECT LIVED. HE BOUGHT THE SOLDIERS A BEER AND TALKED TO THEM. TWO (2) OTHER MEN CAME INTO THE ROOM AND ASKED IF THE SOLDIERS WERE AMERICANS. THE SOLDIERS DECIDED THEY WANTED TO LEAVE, SO THE SUBJECT DROVE THEM TO THE CENTER OF TOWN.

CONSCIENTIOUSNESS AND HIS MATURE HANDLING OF THE
SITUATION.
