References:

- a. Your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request for records concerning various dossiers. Your request was received in this office on April 18, 2001.
- b. Our letter of April 20, 2001, informing you that additional time was needed to review the records and we were unable to comply with the 20-day statutory time limit.

We have conducted checks of the automated Defense Clearance and Investigations Index and a search of the Investigative Records Repository to determine the existence of Army intelligence investigative records responsive to your request.

We have located records pertaining to your request on Czechoslovakia Intelligence Services Tradescraft, ZF400205W. We have completed a mandatory declassification review in accordance with Executive Order (EO) 12958. As a result of our review, information has been sanitized and 162 pages of records are denied in their entirety as the information is currently and properly classified SECRET and CONFIDENTIAL according to Sections 1.3(a)(2), 1.3(a)(3), 1.5(b) and 1.5(c) of EO 12958. This information is exempt from the public disclosure provisions of the FOIA pursuant to Title 5 U.S. Code 552(b)(1). It is not possible to reasonably segregate meaningful portions of the withheld pages for release. On March 9, 1999, the President exempted the file series in which these records are maintained from the automatic declassification provisions of EO 12958, Section 3.4, pertaining to classified records more than 25 years old. The records are enclosed for your use. A brief explanation of the applicable sections follows:

Section 1.3(a)(2) of EO 12958 provides that information shall be classified SECRET it is unauthorized disclosure reasonably could be expected to cause serious damage to the national security.

Section 1.3(a)(3) of EO 12958 provides that information shall be classified CONFIDENTIAL if its unauthorized disclosure reasonably could be expected to cause damage to the national security.

Section 1.5(b) of EO 12958 provides that foreign government information shall be considered for classification protection.

Section 1.5(c) of EO 12958 provides that information pertaining to intelligence activities, intelligence sources or methods, and cryptologic information shall be considered for classification protection.

Since the release of the information would result in an unwarranted invasion of the privacy rights of the individual concerned, this information is exempt from the public disclosure provisions of the FOIA per Title 5 U.S. Code 552 (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C).

In addition, information has been sanitized from the records and 162 pages of the same pages withheld under (b)(1) are also denied in their entirety, as the release of the information would reveal the identity of confidential sources and sensitive investigative methodologies. This information is exempt from public disclosure pursuant to Title 5 U.S. Code 552 (b)(7)(D) and (b)(7)(E). The significant and legitimate governmental purpose to be served by withholding is that a viable and effective intelligence investigative capability is dependent upon protection of confidential sources and sensitive investigative methodologies.

In summary, we have denied a total of 162 pages, because of one or more exemptions.

The withholding of the information described above is a partial denial of your request. This denial is made on behalf of Major General Keith B. Alexander, the Commanding General, U.S. Army Intelligence and Security Command, who is the Initial Denial Authority for Army intelligence investigative and security records under the FOIA. You have the right to appeal this decision to the Secretary of the Army. If you wish to file an appeal, you should forward it to this office. Your appeal must be postmarked no later than 60 calendar days from the date of this letter. After the 60-day period, the case may be considered closed; however, such closure does not preclude you from filing litigation in the courts.

1. Let Attached, for your information and retention, is an English translation of a German language technical report pertaining to three clandestine film containers contrived for intelligence use. The containers were found by West German authorities among the possessions of Czech intelligence agents involved in the Alfred Frenzel espionage case.

2. (2) These ingenious containers are of special interest in that they contain devices designed to destroy their content if opened by a person unfamiliar with their mechanism. Two of the containers were fashioned as clandestine receptacles for microfilms. The thild is somewhat larger and could conceal money or popers as well as film,

3. It Unfortunately, the photographs of the containers on heir mechanisms which accompany the report are of poor quality. CIAS, CI Branch has requested DCSI, USAREUR, to endeavor to obtain clear negatives of photographs of these items from the German authorities. Recipients of the attached report who may be interested in obtaining quality prints of any such negatives which may be furnished are requested to so advise CI Branch, attention CIAS.

### Photographing documents with a Leise camera (elder type)

The object will be attached to a vertical plane (a wall, embinet, etc.), or we may prop it against a book standing with its back upward.

For lighting, 2 table lamps of 60-75 W each will do, placed at a distance of 60 continuous from the object. The object must be uniformly lit.

Any ordinary panchromatic Z1/10 DIM or 17/10 DIM 35-cm film may be used.

The Leisa sensers will always be affixed to a tripod and face the object vertically at a distance of 1 meter (measured from the back of the camera ease). The lense will be adjusted to a range of 1 m, the range will be shocked in the range-finder. The script must show clearly defined outlines in the range-finder. If out of focus, adjustment will be made by operating the range adjuster. The lens opening will be adjusted to f: 6.3.

At the foregoing distance the film will be exposed 1/20th of a second if it is 21/10 DIN fast, and 1/10 of a second if 17/10 DIN fast.

Exposure will preferably be attained by means of a wire trigger. Under the foregoing conditions it is possible to also take free-handed pictures (without a tripod). It is necessary to see to it that the pictures will be gharp and that the camera is not moved.

A REPORT OF FINDINGS

On 15 June 1950 German Customs Police stationed at NEUKIRCHEN (N50/U88) stated to the undersigned that on 5 June 1950 while on patrol in the vicinity of NEUKIRCHEN between BUCHET (N49/U74) and SILBERBACH (cna) in the forest extending to the OSSER Mountain they saw two men fleeing from Bavaria toward the CSR. The police were unable to apprehend or to obtain a description of the fugitives; however, they picked up the envelope with contents (attached as Exhibit "A") which they believed was dropped by the fleeing men. The envelope contains a notebook of coded notations utilizing shorthand, figures and notes of music plus papers which appear to be sections of a map also marked in code.
