This responds to your request to the under the Freedom of Information Act dated 16 April 2001. Therein you requested documents from the Department of the Army (DOA) regarding Poland Intelligence Services. In processing your request, DOA located four documents responsive to your request and forwarded them to DIA on 23 September 2002 for review and direct response to you. Of those, one has been referred to another government agency for their review and direct response to you.


Upon review, it has been determined that some portions of two documents are not releasable. The portions withheld are exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(1), (b)(2), (b)(3) and (b)(6), Freedom of Information Act. Subsection (b)(1) applies to information properly classified under the criteria provided by Executive Order 12958. Subsection (b)(2) applies to information that pertains solely to the internal rules and practices of the agency. Subsection (b)(3) applies to information specifically exempted by a statute establishing particular criteria for withholding. The applicable statute is 10 U.S.C. Section 424. Subsection (b)(6) applies to information which if released would constitute an unwarranted invasion of the personal privacy of other individuals. All reasonably segregable portions of the documents are attached hereto.

All substantive portions of the remaining document are not releasable. The withheld portions are exempt from release pursuant to 5 U.S.C. 552 (b)(1), (b)(2), (b)(3) and (b)(6), Freedom of Information Act. There are no reasonably segregable portions of this exempt material.

You are advised that a requester may appeal, within 60 days, an initial decision to withhold a record or part thereof. Should you wish to exercise this right, you may do so by referring to case number 0022-03 and addressing your appeal to:

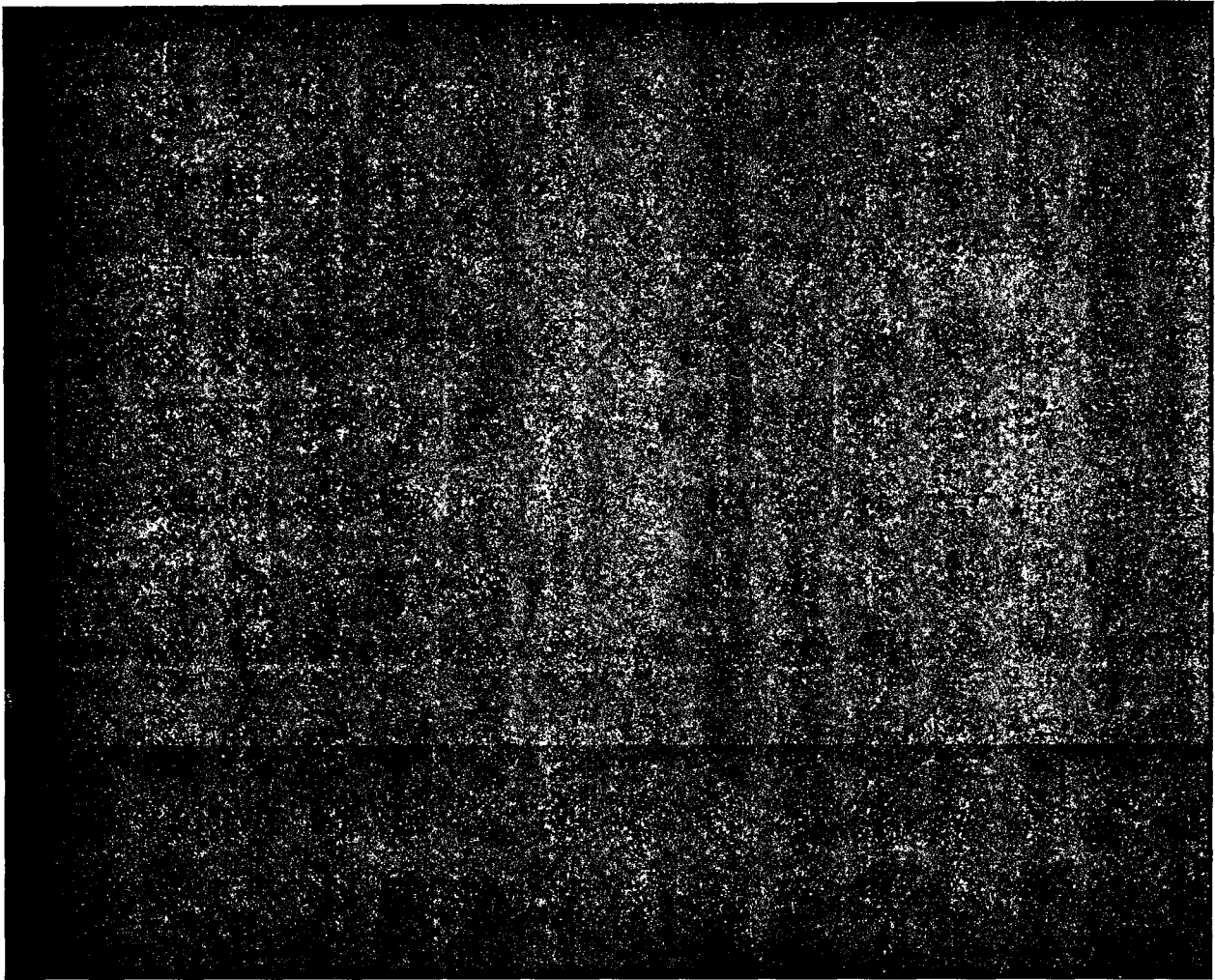

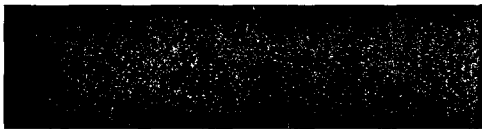

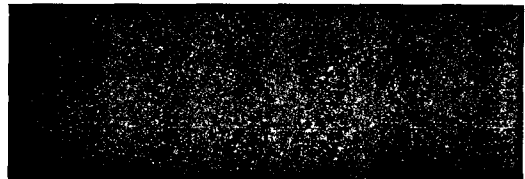

1943: Entered the 1st Polish Army in USA where he was assigned duty as Political Officer. Advanced to the rank of Major.

1945-49: Various positions within the Political apparatus of the Silesian Military District.

1950-53: Transferred to the GZP and assigned as Chief of Administration II of the GZP.

1954: Advanced to position of Chief of GZP.

1955-Dec 56: Promoted to Brig General and remained as Chief of GZP.

Dec 56: Criticized as being pro-Stalinist and was on the verge of being decapitated. With the support of GZP was able to remain in service but was reassigned duty with Administration II (General II) of the General Staff, where he remained until Mar 57.

Mar 57-59: Military Attache to Bulgaria

1959: Military Attache to Moscow.
