References:

- a. Your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of March 29, 2001, for records concerning various dossiers. Your request was received in this office on April 18, 2001.
- b. Our letter of April 20, 2001, informing you that additional time was needed to review the records and we were unable to comply to the 20-day statutory time limit in processing your request.

We have conducted checks of the automated Defense Clearance and Investigations Index and a search of the Investigative Records Repository to determine the existence of Army intelligence investigative records responsive to your request.

We have located the enclosed records pertaining to Soviet Mission United Nations, ZF010316W. We have completed a mandatory declassification review in accordance with Executive Order 12958. As a result of this review, it has been determined that the Army-originated information no longer warrants classification protection and is partially releasable to you. The records are enclosed for your use. Fees for processing this request are waived.

Information has been sanitized from these records which would result in an unwarranted invasion of the personnel privacy rights of the individuals concerned. This information is exempt from the public disclosure provisions of the FOIA per Title 5 U.S. Code 552 (b)(6) and (b)(7)(C).

The withholding of information by this office is a partial denial of your request. This denial is made on behalf of Brigadier General Keith B. Alexander, the Commanding General, U.S. Army Intelligence and Security Command, who is the Initial Denial Authority for Army intelligence investigative and security records under the FOIA. You may appeal this decision to the

This is a summary of investigation conducted in an attempt to identify the Unknown Subject in this case. To establish a base from which to start, certain known facts were relied upon. Among these were, Subject is a male, [redacted] years old (as of [redacted] in the Military, and [redacted] and absent without official leave (AWOL) from the service [redacted]

On October 11, 1966, Colonel Harold W. Smith, Director of Security ARADCOM, Headquarters, Schlarb Building, Ent Air Force Base, Colorado, advised that ARADCOM consists of numerous missile sites around the Continental United States. Records of AWOL personnel are available, ARADCOM, Headquarters, Colorado Springs, Colorado. Colonel Smith advised that in addition to regularly assigned ARADCOM missile personnel, there are National Guard units which have personnel attached to missile sites. He said no record is kept specifically of AWOLs from the National Guard units. Colonel Smith, however, determined by telephone calls to the various regions of ARADCOM that at that time there were no AWOLs from National Guard units.

Colonel Smith advised that there are "missilemen" assigned to the Army Missile Command at Redstone Arsenal at Huntsville, Alabama, and that there is a missile schools at Army Air Defense Center, Fort Bliss, Texas. It was further

pointed out that the infantry in the entire United States Army is equipped with "Rockets" and the individuals handling this type of missile could conceivably be called "missilemen".

1. (U) Reference is made to staff visits by Mr. Strecker, your office, to this headquarters on 11 October 1966 and 2 March 1967 wherein Mr. Strecker was advised as to the status and progress of subject investigation.

2. (S) The following is a chronological development of subject investigation to date:

a. 17 September 1966. Appropriate records checks by the 113th MI Group identified two soldiers (SP5 [redacted] and PVT [redacted] who were reported as being AWOL on the first weekend in September 1966.

b. 19 September 1966. The 113th MI Group was directed to interview [redacted] a knowledgeable AWOL, upon his return to military control and to coordinate the interview with the FBI, St. Louis, Missouri.

c. 22 September 1966. The 113th MI Group was advised by FBI, St. Louis, that the proposed interview of [redacted] would be conducted by their office and that they did not concur in having MI interview [redacted]. On advice from Mr. Strecker, your office, the 113th MI Group informed FBI, St. Louis, of our normal debriefing procedures re Knowledgeable AWOL (KAWOL), citing AR 381-130 and USAINTC Regulation 380-100; stressed that secret information previously furnished by the FBI would not be disclosed during the KAWOL debriefing; and that if information was developed of FBI interest, their office would be promptly notified. FBI, St. Louis, was also invited to be present during the debriefing if they so desired. They were also advised that if they continued to non-concur in the MI debriefing of [redacted] the matter of who conducts the debriefing would have to be resolved at the national level.

d. 23 September 1966. FBI, St. Louis, advised that they continue to non-concur in the interview of [redacted] being conducted by MI and that, although they consider the matter routine, they are requesting their headquarters to resolve jurisdiction at the national level. On advice of Mr. Strecker, your office, the 113th MI Group was advised to proceed with the debriefing of [redacted] independent of the FBI, St. Louis.

e. 26 September 1966. SP5 [redacted] was interviewed by a Special Agent, 113th MI Group. Interview disclosed that SP5 [redacted] was AWOL during the period 8 through 12 September 1966. Nothing of apparent intelligence value was disclosed during the interview.

f. 30 September 1966. Mr. Strecker, your office, telephonically advised of the results of SP5 [redacted] interview and advised that he did not desire a copy of the interview.

g. 10 October 1966. FBI, St. Louis, advised that the FBI had contacted USARADCOM, Colorado Springs, Colorado, to obtain the names of all persons who were AWOL during the period in question and that it is their intention to interview all persons once identified and located. They also advised that they intended to interview two deserters [redacted]

[redacted] presently in custody at the Special Processing Detachment, Fort Leonard Wood, Missouri. They further advised that they would provide information of military interest to appropriate authorities but would not concur with the presence of an MI agent during the interviews.

h. 11 October 1966. Mr. Strecker, during the staff visit referenced in paragraph 1, above, was furnished a copy of the autovon message from the 113th MI Group which reported the information in paragraph 2h, above. [redacted] Since Mr. Strecker did not indicate that his office intended to raise the jurisdictional issue with the FBI on the national level, it was the conclusion of this office that because of the "needle-in-the-haystack" nature of this investigation, the FBI would continue to interview army AWOL's with this command investigating other leads surfaced by screening of appropriate army records. (u) FBI INFO

i. December 1966 through February 1967. This command was furnished a series of FBI reports, forwarded by your office, containing the results of interviews with members of the US Army. In forwarding these FBI reports, no jurisdictional questions were raised by your office.

j. 2 March 1967. During a staff visit, this date, by Mr. Strecker, he was advised that, in view of the FBI investigation, this command was limiting itself to screening of records for leads to the identification of subject.

k. 17 September 1966 to present. This office has reviewed the results of all CONUS KAWOL investigations and USAIRR dossiers of those individuals interviewed by the FBI for information leading to the identification of subject. Results have proved negative to date.

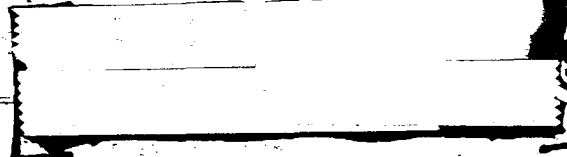

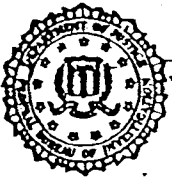



This request by subject was made in a flippant and mildly sarcastic manner.

The original information does not explicitly indicate that subject is stationed in St. Louis (as indicated in attached FBI report, dated 13 September 1966), and that the only inference which may be logically made from the original information is that subject may possibly be stationed in the St. Louis area.

4. (u) On 15 September 1966, FBI National Headquarters requested the St. Louis FBI Office to initiate a limited investigation in that area in an attempt to determine the identity of subject. The Department of the Army is to be notified of the results of this investigation. (u) FBI INFO

5. (u) The FBI advised this office that the Bureau desires to defer furnishing the Department of the Army with a copy of the original information because of the sensitivity of the source involved. In this connection, the FBI further stated that if the Department of the Army absolutely required the original information, suitable arrangements could be made at a time when sufficient information concerning subject is developed which warrants limited distribution of the original information. 


